

Minutes

The Athletic Trainers Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on September 1, 2011 in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Mr. McKibbin called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and asked for a roll call. Members present were:

Mr. McKibbin noted the absence of Dr. Kenneth Smith. Dr. Smith had passed away in June. Mr. McKibbin said his work and his value to this Committee would be greatly missed.

The minutes from the February 17, 2011 meeting were reviewed. Mr. Brown moved to approve the minutes as presented. Mr. Chlouber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Lyle Kelsey, Executive Director of the Board and Billy Stout, MD, Director of the APPA Program, presented information on the Allied Professional Peer Assistance program. Mr. Kelsey explained the need for the program, the history of the development of the program, and the organization and staffing of the program. Dr. Stout said Medical Board members had always been concerned about inconsistencies in the way allied professionals were evaluated and treated compared to physicians, most likely for economic reasons. This program was developed to provide a consistent, economic, but quality, professional, state-of-the-art program for the allied professionals licensed by the Board.

MATTHEW HUNT appeared in support of his application for Apprentice Athletic Trainer licensure. Mr. Hunt was present to discuss his 2005 misdemeanor assault and battery charge. After hearing testimony and reviewing the application, Mr. Brown moved to recommend approval of the application. Mr. Chlouber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JOE WHITT appeared in support of his application for reinstatement of Athletic Trainer licensure. Mr. Whitt's licensure had expired in 2003. He testified regarding his activities since that time. He said he had been practicing as a physical therapist during that time and had not maintained AT licensure or BOC certification. He said he was planning on pursuing recertification. Mr. Whitt testified regarding his continuing education. Mr. Brown moved to recommend approval of the application. Mr. Chlouber suggested having Mr. Whitt practice under the supervision of another AT for a time with a report to the Committee at next meeting on his progress. Mr. McKibbin moved to table the application until next the next meeting, grant Mr. Whitt a temporary license under the general supervision of Dr. Jackson and Mr. Bourland, and have Mr. Whitt appear with his supervisors at the next meeting with reports from both supervisors. He further moved to have Mr. Whitt report on his continuing education hours, his progress towards BOC recertification, and

completion of all other deficiencies. Mr. Brown seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
