

## Minutes

The Athletic Trainers Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on February 6, 2013, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

The minutes from the August 29, 2012, meeting were reviewed. Mr. Brown moved to approve the minutes as presented. Dr. Northcutt seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**ANTHONY KATZENMEIER** appeared in support of his application for reinstatement of Athletic Trainer licensure. Mr. Katzenmeier's license had expired August 31, 2011. Mr. Katzenmeier stated he had moved a couple of times and did not get the renewal notice. He said he came from Illinois where licensure renewal was every two years so he did not check on his licensure status until 2012. He admitted he made a mistake. He stated he worked while his license was inactive. Once he realized the license was inactive, he applied for reinstatement and receive a temporary license in September 2012. After discussion, Mr. Brown moved to recommend approval of the reinstatement application. Mr. Chlouber seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**MELISSA WERGELES** appeared in support of her application for licensure as an Apprentice Athletic Trainer. Ms. Wergeles had been arrested for DUI twice, once in 2009 and again in 2010. A proposed Agreement for licensure was presented. Mr. McKibbin reported that Ms. Wergeles was at the University of Central Oklahoma's Athletic Trainer program and had been subject to a background check and drug test during her first year there. Ms. Wergeles said she is not yet driving but will be eligible in April to have the license reinstated once she passes a breathalyzer. She stated she has completed all the court-mandated requirements resulting from her conviction. Mr. Chlouber moved to recommend approval of the application under terms of the Agreement. Mr. Millwee stated that his employer had asked him to get the license in case he does not pass the BOC certification exam next week. The vote on the motion was called and was unanimous in the affirmative. Mr. Brown moved to recommend Mr. Millwee for full Athletic Training licensure pending his passing the exam and satisfactory completion of his file.
