

Minutes

The Registered Electrologist Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on October 5, 2009, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 5104 N. Francis, Suite C, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Members present were:

The meeting was called to order at 8:30 a.m. The minutes from the February 23, 2009 meeting were reviewed. Ms. McNeely moved to approve the minutes. Ms. Goodman seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KIMBERLY STOUT, RN appeared in support of her application to begin the preceptorship training for Registered Electrologist licensure. The Committee reviewed Ms. Stout's education. Ms. Stout asked if her nutrition class could be substituted for chemistry. She stated that it was a very chemistry-oriented nursing class. The Committee reviewed the law and rules for a way to accept the class but the rules were very specific. The Committee encouraged Ms. Stout to be an active participant in the Oklahoma State Electrology Association.

They discussed with her the examination process. The Committee encouraged her also to actively participate in the State Association.
