

## Registered Electrologist Advisory Committee

### Minutes

The Registered Electrologist Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision held a Special Meeting on June 19, 2017, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The special meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this special meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on June 1, 2017, and posted on the Board's website on June 15, 2017. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on June 15, 2017 at 11:15 a.m.

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Casteel called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Casteel moved to approve the minutes of the meeting held on January 30, 2017, as written. Ms. Winzeler seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee reviewed the application of **JULIANNE BUSHONG, RE**, for approval as preceptor. Ms. Casteel moved to recommend approval of **JULIANNE BUSHONG, RE**, as preceptor. Ms. Winzeler seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**BETH LASHLEY** appeared in support of her application for Registered Electrologist licensure. Ms. Lashley has not yet taken microbiology but plans to take it during training. The Committee believes the anatomy course required for licensure covers the endocrine system which is important in the field of electrology so it is a possibility that she may need to take a human anatomy course as well, although the applicant has worked in a medical setting for the past 18 years. The applicant stated she is willing to take a human anatomy/physiology course. Ms. Casteel moved to recommend approval of **BETH LASHLEY** for training on the condition she supplies proof of satisfactory completion of the college courses of microbiology and human anatomy/physiology before applying for the Registered Electrologist licensure examination. Ms. Winzeler seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The Committee advised Applicant that she is eligible to begin training immediately.

The Committee then reviewed continuing education units that were presented for approval. The Committee was very appreciative of the CEUs being presented in list form by Ms. Mitchell. Ms. Casteel moved to accept the continuing education units as presented. Ms. Winzeler seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (*See Attachment #1*)
