DISCIPLINARY MATTERS

Kenneth Ewell Baird, MD – *Disciplinary hearing alleging disciplinary action in another state and sexual misconduct* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted imposing a \$10,000 fine, ethics CME and a boundaries course.

Kimberly Dawn Barnett, RC – *Disciplinary hearing alleging substance abuse and narcotics violations* – Five year probation imposed with terms including drug testing and psychiatric counseling.

Maria Jean Lucas, RC – *Disciplinary hearing alleging fraud and felony conviction* – License revoked based on Medicaid fraud conviction.

Duncan Langston McRae, MD – *Disciplinary hearing alleging failure to properly supervise a Physician Assistant* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted imposing a 60-day suspension, \$5000 fine, and prohibition on supervising Physician Assistants.

Richard Clay Tessmer, PA – *Disciplinary hearing alleging fraud, substance abuse and sexual misconduct* – License revoked

Michael Curtis West, MD – *Disciplinary hearing alleging aiding and abetting unlicensed practice of medicine and prescribing violations* – Proposed settlement rejected. Case continued to the May 20, 2010 Board meeting with Dr. West's agreement not to practice during the pendency of his case.

Paul Christopher Francel, MD – *Disciplinary hearing alleging inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety* - Proposed Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction rejected. Case set for hearing May 20, 2010 with Dr. Francel's agreement not to practice during the pendency of his case.
