- ZACHARIAH JESSIC ANDERSON, MD** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging substance abuse, failure to report adverse action to the Board, and fraud or misrepresentation in reregistration of a medical license* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted imposing a one month suspension followed by indefinite probation.
- ROBI PAUL CHATTERJI, MD** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging sexual misconduct* – Two year probation and \$15,000 fine imposed
- DAVID PAUL CRASS, MD** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging prescribing violations* - Revoked
- JOHN ROY DOSSER, MD** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging conduct likely to deceive/defraud/harm the public, confession of a crime, and commission of an act connected to the practice of medicine in violation of criminal laws* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted imposed a Formal Reprimand
- PHILIP ANDRE FLOYD, MD** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging inability to practice with reasonable skill/safety, substance abuse, fraud in applying for license, confession of crime, and failure to report adverse action by a court* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted imposing a minimum of four months suspension beginning January 12, 2012, after which time he may apply for reinstatement under terms of a five year probation.
- TONI MICHELLE JONES, PA** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging inability to practice with reasonable skill/safety, substance abuse, confession of crime, medical records violations and prescribing violations* – Final Order of Indefinite Suspension accepted
- GLENA KAY MACKEY, OT** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging fraud, abuse, record keeping violations, and conviction of a crime* - Revoked
- RACHEL LYNN WADDELL, PTA** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging fraud, abuse, record keeping violations, conviction of a crime and failure to report adverse action to the Board* - Voluntary Surrender in Lieu of Prosecution accepted
- SUZZIE WALDENVILLE, PA** – *Disciplinary hearing alleging dishonorable/immoral conduct, prescribing violations, narcotic law violations, records violations, failure to establish a physician/patient relationship, and failure to obtain informed consent* – Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction rejected
