CHARLES ERIC ECKMAN, MD – Disciplinary hearing alleging dishonorable or immoral conduct likely to deceive; prescribing or administering controlled substances or narcotics in excess; office records violations; violation of criminal laws in connection with the physician’s practice of medicine; prescribing or administering a drug or treatment without valid physician-patient relationship; inability to practice medicine with reasonable skill and safety; prescribing, selling, administering, distributing or giving any drug legally classified as a controlled substance for other than medically accepted therapeutic purposes; prescribing, selling, administering, distributing, ordering, or giving to a habitue or addict or any person previously drug dependent on any drug legally classified as a controlled substance - *Voluntary Submittal to Jurisdiction accepted pending review by the Oklahoma Attorney General*
