

*Corrected Minutes

The Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on October 6, 2016, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 1, 2015, and posted on the Board's website on October 4, 2016. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, OK on October 4, 2016 at 2:30 p.m.

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. and welcomed the visiting class of the Occupational Therapy Assistant students from Oklahoma City Community College.

Following Committee review, Ms. Garza moved to approve the minutes of July 7, 2016, as written. Ms. Hancock seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

*The matter of **MARY HUFF**, applicant, Occupational Therapy Assistant, was called. Ms. Huff did not appear. The Committee moved to the next item on the agenda.

The matter of **NINA MADSEN, applicant, Occupational Therapy Assistant, was called. Ms. Madsen did not appear. The Committee moved to the next item on the agenda.

CLARANN LOUISE MAYFIELD appeared in support of her application for Occupational Therapist licensure. Her application is complete. She graduated in 1999 and last practiced in 2000. Applicant provided a handout showing approximately 29.1 continuing education units for Committee review. Applicant stated she also has an additional 15.5 CEUs

that were submitted with her initial application. Applicant's Kansas license expired in May of 2001. Following Committee discussion, Mr. Lee moved that 100 verified CEUs are to be completed within one calendar year of this date, of which 50% must be live or direct and the other 50% may be online, *and* Applicant must have direct supervision as defined for a minimum of three months or a minimum of 66 days where a minimum of 6 hours per day of direct supervision is accomplished. Additionally, compliance documentation of all requirements must be submitted to the Committee for its review within one calendar year of this date. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Following further discussion, Mr. Lee moved to recommend approval for licensure pending completion of the file and the previously stated requirements. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

EMILY WILSON appeared in support of her application for reinstatement of Occupational Therapist licensure. She provided a handout for Committee review which included a supervisor evaluation and proof of continuing education units (CEUs) obtained. She previously appeared in October of 2015 and was required to obtain 360 hours of direct face-to-face CEUs and three months of 32-hour weeks, or 66 6-hour days, of direct on-site supervision to be completed no later than October 6, 2016. The Committee stated that 32.25 direct CEUs had already been obtained. Ms. White moved to require 27 hours of direct on-site supervision and decrease the previous number of required CEUs to 100 hours with 50% direct attendance and 50% distance learning with compliance documentation due no later than March 24th, 2017 and a personal appearance before the Committee in April of 2017. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Following further discussion, Ms. White recommended approval for licensure pending completion of the file and the previously stated requirements. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

*Following Committee discussion, Mr. Lee tabled the application of **MARY HUFF MATTHEWS** for Occupational Therapy Assistant pending a personal appearance on January 5, 2017. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Following Committee discussion, Mr. Lee tabled the application of **NINA MADSEN for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure. Ms. Hancock seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Lee moved to approve the pre-reviewed list for continuing education as presented pursuant to reviewer's recommendations. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. *(See Attachment #1)*

Following Committee review, Ms. White moved to approve the continuing education document documentation presented in the meeting (loose documentation to be put in list form). Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. *(See Attachment #2)*

Lyle Kelsey, Executive Director, requested that the agenda be re-ordered and Agenda Item No. 8 be taken up at this time. Committee Chair granted permission and Luke Martin, Legislative Liaison, and Mr. Kelsey presented a legislative review to the Committee regarding the steps for new laws and rules to be implemented. Two important points to know are to work through your association and select a legislative author that is, hopefully, serving on a health committee and knowledgeable about the issue at hand as well as committed to see it through. Any legislator can open up a practice act at any time and that is just the nature of the business. Mr. Martin stated the House will experience the largest turnover they have ever had in the upcoming session so a lot of education will need to occur. Charles McCall will be the new House Speaker and Mike Schultz will be the Pro-Temp and there will not be a majority party in the House or Senate. Mr. Martin stated he believes the budget will not be much better than last year. Early November is the bill filing deadline. December 11th is the date for general language submission and January 21st is the deadline for actual bill language submission. The session opens February 1, 2017. Mr. Kelsey advised it is encouraged to let the author know what the negative impact might be so he/she is not blindsided. The Advisory Committee may look at wording and suggest changes, but once it gets into the legislation, the association has a bigger role in that regard. He stated that from an agency or board standpoint, it is not our place to lobby at the capitol; it is up to the association to speak for or against any proposed legislation. The Committee thanked Mr. Martin and Mr. Kelsey for their time.

Reji Varghese walked the Committee through a presentation on approving requests for continuing education units (CEUs) electronically. He stated that the Physical Therapy Advisory Committee is in the process of beginning to utilize this mechanism and it is a modular system and may be easily adapted to other professions. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Garza moved to allow staff to move forward with electronic CEU submissions for the OT profession. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Mr. Varghese stated he will reach out to committee members to obtain guidance where specific information and knowledge is needed.

Next, the Committee heard from Teresa Mitchell, Licensing Director, regarding the potential need for language governing the late renewal process, *Okla. Admin. Code 435:30-1-5*. Ms. Mitchell asked the Committee if they would like to see information in addition to the renewal form for late licensure renewals. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Garza moved for the renewal process to remain the same with no additional information requested. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The floor was then opened for public comments regarding tele-therapy as it relates to the practice of occupational therapy in Oklahoma. Mr. Kelsey stated that while the amount of time each speaker holds the floor may be limited, the number of speakers cannot be limited. Gaytha Ziegelmeier, OTR/L, Tara Bailey, OTR/L, and Dinda Rachel, OTR/L took the floor and Ms. Ziegelmeier spoke on behalf of all three participants. She stated that they own Occupational Therapy Solutions in Ada and serve the southwest regions in Oklahoma, primarily in the school system. Ms. Zigelmier provided an outline of her comments for the convenience of the Committee. *(See Attachment #3)* She stated that they are concerned about patient safety, believe that tele-therapy is currently being manipulated to include the internet and ~~that a paraprofessional is providing occupational therapy in a school system via tele-therapy~~ *that a paraprofessional on-site is providing occupational therapy without supervision of a licensed occupational therapist. Ms. Ziegelmeier stated they are also concerned that a certain amount of income will be taken out of the state due to tele-therapy. The Committee stated there are situations that can be effective and appropriate for the use of tele-therapy and those situations need to be identified. Committee Chair stated that the language used in any proposed law/rule will be most important since there are situations where parents and caregivers are providing home care. The Committee stated the most important factor is patient care and safety and to ensure the citizens are protected. Mr. Kelsey stated that if Ms. Ziegelmeier would email her concerns regarding a paraprofessional providing occupational therapy via tele-health, he will have an investigation opened in the matter.

The Committee then reviewed documents provided by Ms. Garza from the National Board of Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT) in its 2014 conference regarding Tele-Therapy. This matter was provided for informational purposes only and the Committee took no action.

Mr. Lee requested that the Committee review the need to set timelines on the development of recommendations for Tele-Therapy as it relates to the practice of occupational therapy in Oklahoma. Ms. Smith provided the names of the current members of the sub-committee which was formed in July of 2015. Ms. Garza proposed to seek out information from the upcoming telehealth conference in Oklahoma as well as touch base with her contacts who are interested in serving on the sub-committee. Ms. Hancock will touch base with her contact on the sub-committee (Stephanie Whitney). Ms. Garza stated she would like for the sub-committee to meet in January of 2017 with a projected legislative review in 2018. Mr. Lee stated he will provide the Oklahoma Occupational Therapy Association leadership and legislative contacts to Ms. Garza. Ms. Smith was directed to put the presentation of a report by the Tele-Therapy sub-committee on the April 6, 2017 agenda.

Following Committee review, Ms. White moved to accept the following dates for 2017 Committee Meetings: **January 5, 2017; April 6, 2017; June 29, 2017 and October 19, 2017.** Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the floor was opened to the Occupational Therapy Assistant students from Oklahoma City Community College. Following a question and answer session, the students thanked the Committee for their time.

There being no further business, Ms. White moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The meeting was adjourned at 12:15 p.m.
