

Minutes

The Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on February 2, 2017, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this special meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on January 5, 2017, and posted on the Board's website on January 31, 2017. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, OK on January 31, 2017 at 10:15 a.m.

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, the Committee asked to amend the minutes of October 6, 2016, on page 5, paragraph 2 wherein it reads "...that a paraprofessional is providing occupational therapy in a school system via tele-therapy" to instead read "...that a paraprofessional on-site is providing occupational therapy without supervision of a licensed occupational therapist." Ms. White moved to accept the minutes with the correction stated above. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee welcomed the visiting occupational therapy assistant students of Caddo Kiowa Technology Center, Fort Cobb, Oklahoma.

KELLI PAIR appeared in person in support of her application for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure, and to discuss her previous practice as an OTA without submission of proper documentation. Teresa Mitchell stated the applicant applied for licensure in November of 2016,

after failing the national exam in March and May of 2016, but passing in October of 2016. She graduated February of 2016. Ms. Mitchell stated the reason for the personal appearance today is the applicant worked from March to May of 2016 as a Graduate Occupational Therapy Assistant. The rule that applies is Okla. Admin. Code 435:30-10-3 which states, in part, “An applicant...may practice...in the status of a graduate Occupational Therapy student...” Because Ms. Pair had not applied for licensure at the time she began working as a GOTA, she would not have been considered an applicant. Ms. Pair stated she has been employed with Integris Grove for a couple years. She did her rotation at Integris in Grove and is currently employed there as a health unit coordinator. She was offered a graduate OTA occasional part-time position in the OT department under the direct supervision of an OTR at that time. The director of the therapy department stated she could work as a GOTA since she did not pass the national exam in February. She confirmed that she worked from March 16, 2016 to May 13, 2016 as a GOTA under the direct supervision of an OTR.

Upon questioning from the Committee, Ms. Pair stated that her supervising OTR was physically present with her during all of her client visits. Ms. Pair provided inpatient, outpatient and school-related services. Again, she stated the OTR supervisor was in the room with her at all times and that both she and the OTR documented the visits in the medical records. Upon further questioning, she once again confirmed that every single time she saw a client, the OTR was with her at the client’s side. The supervising OT did not see other patients in the hospital, but in the school setting there may be two students that they saw at the same time. She said the school students were the main focus. She treated one student at a desk and the OT supervisor treated one student at a desk right next to her. At that time she ceased working in her role as a GOTA. She does not currently have a temporary license to practice. Ms. Pair stated she does not recall if she has been told in school the Oklahoma licensing procedure and requirements. On February 22 of 2016, Integris Grove requested a release form to receive her transcript from Brown Mackie stating she completed her OTA degree.

Mr. Lee stated the first issue is the applicant did not have a temporary letter to practice nor did she have a Form 5 on file stating she was practicing as a GOTA with proper supervision. Therefore, the rules for proper supervision were not followed. Ms. Wythe interjected that if the Committee would like to do anything other than approve licensure or send a letter of concern to her file, the case would need to be referred for a disciplinary proceeding.

Ms. Pair stated she is not aware of any services that she provided that were billed by the facility, but because she provided patient care it is most likely that her services were billed. She believes she worked approximately 15-20 hours per week from March through May of 2016. In May of 2016, school was out of session and the certified OTA came back from her clinical rotation to become an OTR, so Ms. Pair was no longer needed in the role of GOTA. Teresa Deckard is the OTR who was her supervisor. Donetta Kindell is the certified OTA who was out on rotation.

Ms. Garza issued a staff directive that a letter of no tolerance be put in Applicant’s file advising of this non-compliance issue and that a letter advising of same be sent to the president and program director Scott Wingard, at Brown Mackie College, Integris Grove, Wes McCain, director of therapy department, Grove, Oklahoma, and the HR director, Lori West, at Integris Grove, and Ms. Deckard at Integris Grove. The Committee would like each individual to receive a separate letter, however, Applicant was told that compliance with all licensing rules are ultimately her responsibility.

Following further discussion, Mr. Lee moved to recommend approval of the application of **KELLI PAIR** for Occupational Therapist Assistant licensure. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Ms. Pair was again reminded that compliance with the OT and OTA laws and rules are her responsibility.

MARTHA TUCKER appeared in person for her application for re-entry of Occupational Therapist licensure. Ms. Tucker's Oklahoma license expired in October of 1998 and her Maryland license expired in June of 2014. Her last practice date was May of 2014. She brought proof of 12 earned continuing education units ("CEUs") for Committee review, but they need to be verified by Licensing. She stated that she previously worked in home health care logging approximately 30 hours per week. She is current with the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy ("NBCOT"), but needs twenty-four (24) CEUs for NBCOT by the end of March, 2017. Following Committee discussion, Mr. Lee moved to recommend approval for re-entry of licensure upon completion of the file and obtaining an additional twenty-four (24) hours of continuing education units ("CEUs") by March 31, 2017, of which 50% will be live or on-site, in addition to verification of the twelve (12) completed CEUs. Ms. Hancock seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

PATRICIA DANIEL, Occupational Therapist, appeared in support of her request to supervise a fifth Occupational Therapy Assistant ("OTA"). She stated that all of the OTAs she currently supervises are located in Tahlequah, Oklahoma, and the majority of the clients are being seen in Tahlequah. Ms. Daniel told the Committee she needs a fifth OTA because she has numerous after-school clients and two of her OTAs are pregnant with a third just recently giving birth. She advised that they average approximately 100 clients per week and they are looking at the cases, goals, and progress every three months. Ms. White stated that she believes the number of clients is definitely manageable. Ms. Daniel stated she is on-site at all times and the OTAs are able to ask her questions as they arise. Further, Ms. Daniel conducts annual re-evaluations on every client.

Ms. White advised that when the Committee looks at a supervising OT that has four full-time OTAs, the schedule comes out to 160 supervising hours per week. According to the chart Ms. Daniel provided, she is currently supervising 105 contact hours including the 5th OTA. Ms. Garza moved to grant permission for Ms. Daniel to supervise a fifth Occupational Therapy Assistant, Lorna Gibbs, OTA, until October 18, 2017, with the total number of supervising hours not to exceed 160 hours per week with documentation of supervision to be provided by Ms. Daniel 10 days before each of the remaining 2017 committee meetings, i.e., April 6, 2017, June 29, 2017 and October 19, 2017, with a personal appearance at the October 19, 2017 committee meeting. Ms. Hancock seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Lee moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for Occupational Therapist licensure. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Lee moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application for reinstatement of Occupational Therapist Assistant licensure of **LISA WINBORNE** pending completion of the file. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee reviewed requests for CEU approval for the term 11/1/16 through 10/31/18. Mr. Lee moved to accept as approved or deny as unapproved as indicated on each individual form. Ms. Hancock seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. *(See Attachments #1 and #2)*

Next, Teresa Mitchell presented a spreadsheet on the receipt of Form 5s, Supervision Forms, and how those forms are monitored in the licensing department. Mr. Kelsey stated that getting this information out to initial applicants regarding timely applying for initial licensure and renewals will be of great benefit. Ms. Mitchell stated these could be submitted electronically in the future and the forms could be revised. The Committee stated there is some confusion regarding the three choices at the top of Form 5 and requested to review the revised Form 5 at their April 6th meeting. Ms. Mitchell also stated that Form 5 training will now be included in the student training that she conducts. The Committee was appreciative of the information.

Ms. Mitchell then advised the Committee that the information necessary for the next agenda item, “Review, discussion and possible Staff Directive regarding Supervision, i.e., removal of Occupational Therapy Assistant without prior notification” was still being updated and was unavailable at this time for Committee review. The Committee took no action on this matter at this time.

Next, Ms. Garza gave a brief update on the first meeting of the telehealth subcommittee which was held on December 8, 2016. She stated that Reji Varghese, Deputy Director of the Oklahoma Medical Board, was present and set up a Zoom session for those members who could not be onsite. The subcommittee is made up of seven (7) occupational therapists with a variety of different backgrounds/ practice areas. There is even a member serving on the legislative component of the Oklahoma Occupational Therapy Association (“OKOTA”). The subcommittee plans to look at practice acts of other disciplines around the state. The next meeting is scheduled for February 16, 2017 and an update will be given at the April 6th committee meeting. Mr. Varghese stated that Senate Bill 716 and House Bill 1580 address reimbursement for telehealth activity/encounters. Some of the subcommittee’s goals are to clearly define telehealth terms utilized, the mode of delivery of telehealth and then what that will look like in Oklahoma’s practice act. Mr. Kelsey confirmed that OKOTA is the state professional association and it is OKOTA that actually directs any additional changes to the law through the legislative process as well as exact verbiage requested. If the law is found to be not specific enough to address the matter, then at that point a rule change might be necessary. *(See Attachment #3)*

The Committee then opened the floor for a question and answer session with the visiting occupational therapy assistant students of Caddo Kiowa Technology Center located in Fort

Cobb, Oklahoma. Sarah VanAlstine, vice president of the Oklahoma Occupational Therapy Association, was introduced and welcomed. The Committee thanked the students for their attendance at today's meeting.

There being no further business, Mr. Lee moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The time was 11:10 a.m.
