

Minutes

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Lee called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Thomas Schneider, AAG, asked that each member vote via roll call in keeping with the Oklahoma Attorney General's "best practices" regarding the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act.

The Committee asked Ms. Jordan to file appropriate forms showing that Ms. Butler is a secondary COTA on her license. Following discussion, Ms. Jordan withdrew her request to supervise a fifth COTA and, therefore, no formal action was taken on this matter.

In Ms. Garza's absence, Reji Varghese, Deputy Director, presented a brief report on the telehealth subcommittee. He presented recent OT telehealth survey results to the Committee for its review and stated that 393 responses were received, which is fewer responses than what was received from the 2015 survey, even with strong efforts from the Oklahoma Occupational Therapy Association. The responses have remained in line with the previous survey which tells us the landscape of OT telehealth has not really changed. Mr. Varghese also stated the subcommittee was considering including the survey with the online license renewal to ensure 100 percent participation. He further advised that ZIP codes were requested in this survey to determine practice locations, but that information has not yet been fully analyzed and was not available as a part of this report. A follow-up report will be presented at the next meeting scheduled for July 12, 2018. *(See Attachment #4)*

The Committee then welcomed the visiting Occupational Therapy Assistant students from Caddo Kiowa Technology Center, Fort Cobb, Oklahoma, and Oklahoma City Community College, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The floor was opened to the students for a question-and-answer session. The Committee and staff answered questions primarily regarding licensure and the application process. The students thanked the members for their time.

There being no further business, Ms. Hancock moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The time was 10:19 a.m.

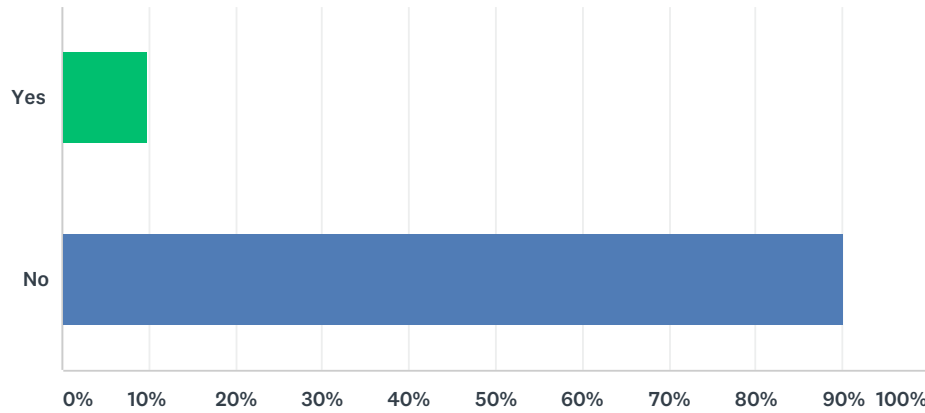

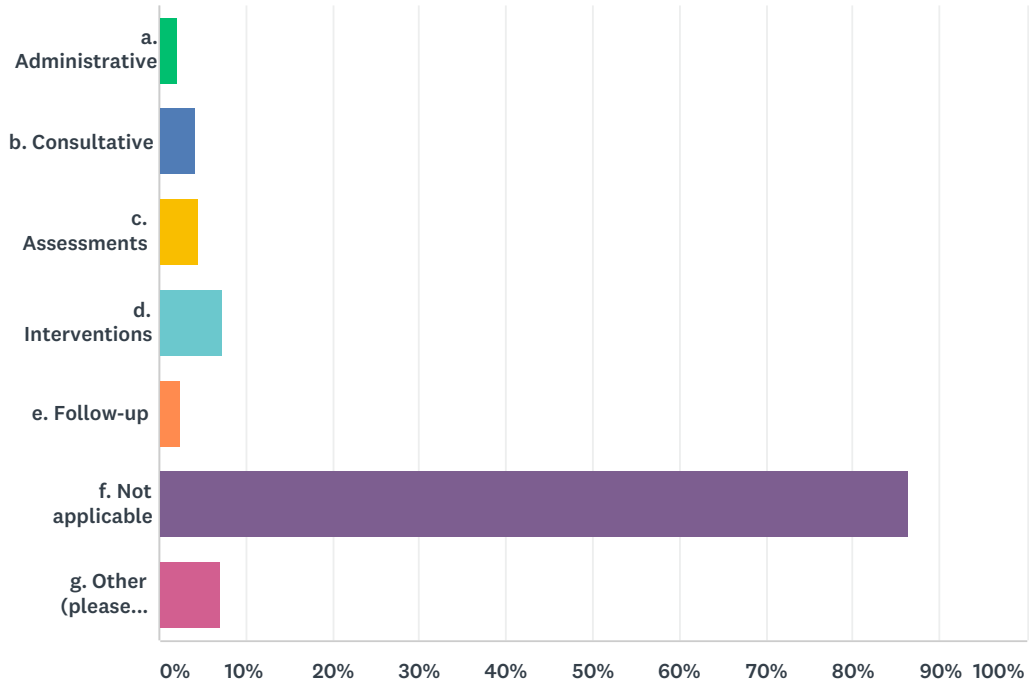

Q4 How do you currently use telemedicine? (Mark all that apply.)

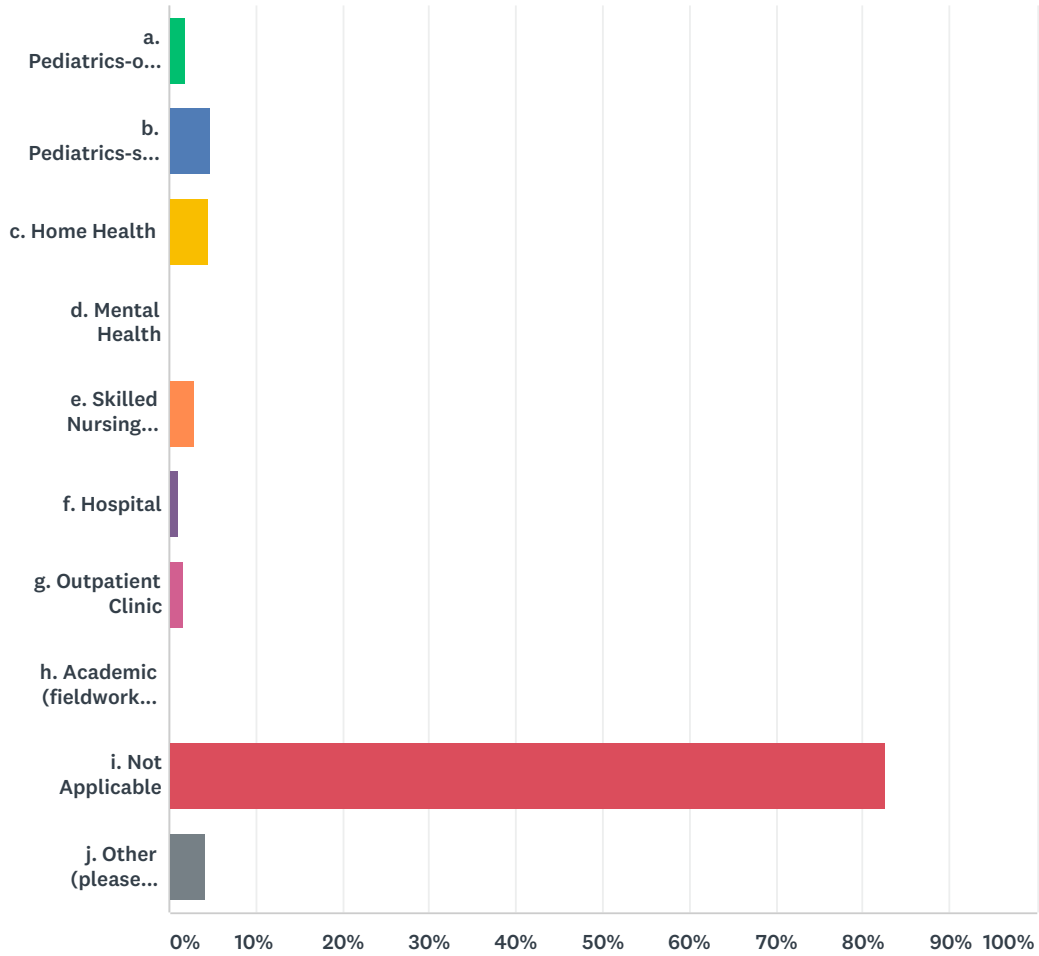

Q5 In what practice area are you currently using telemedicine?

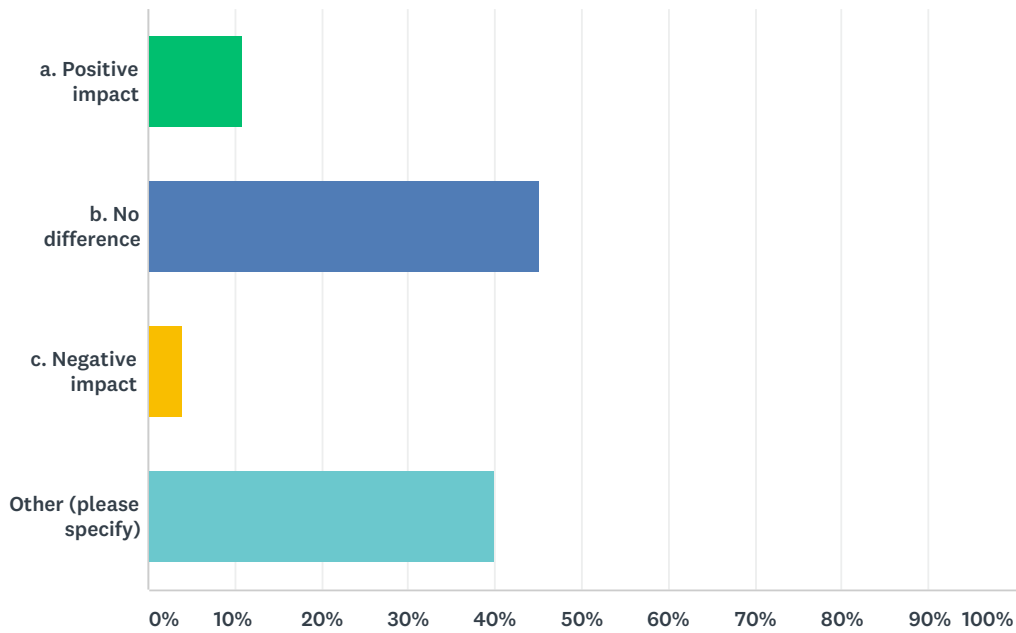

Q6 What kind of patient care impact has telemedicine had on your caseload

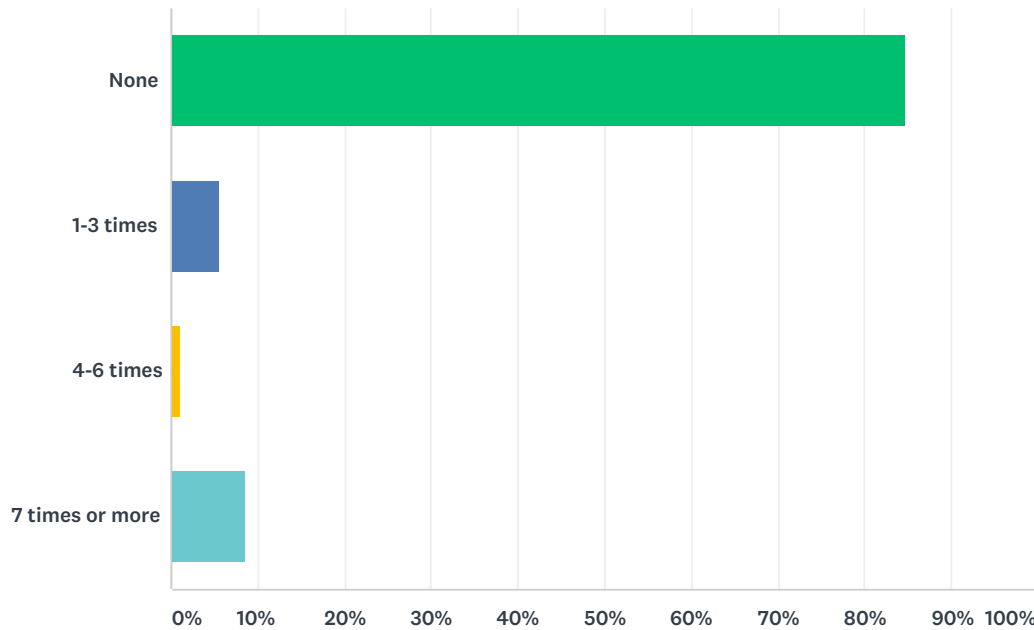

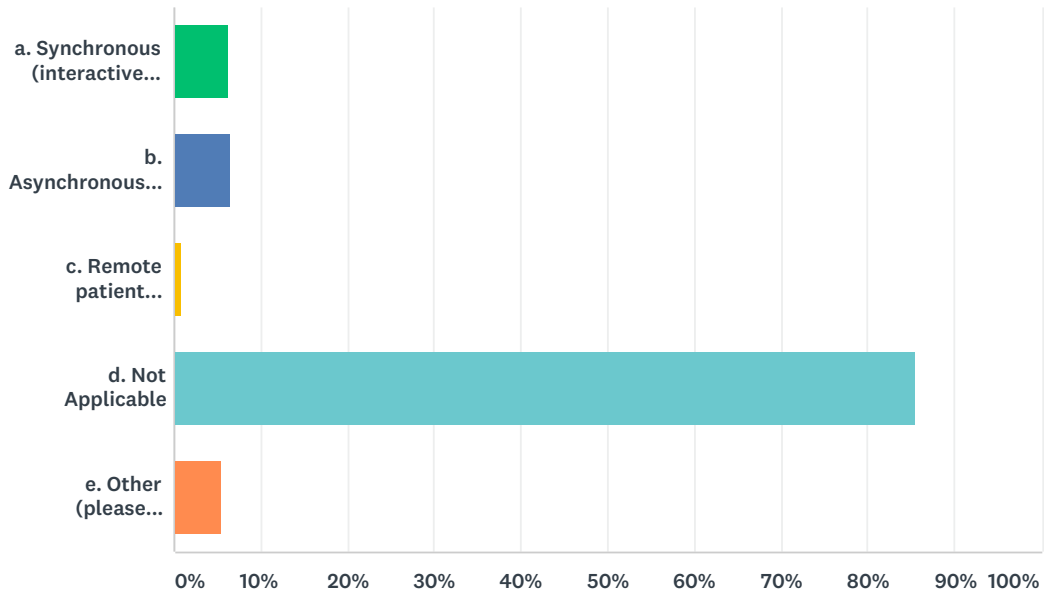

Q8 Does your use of telemedicine involve? (Mark all that apply.)

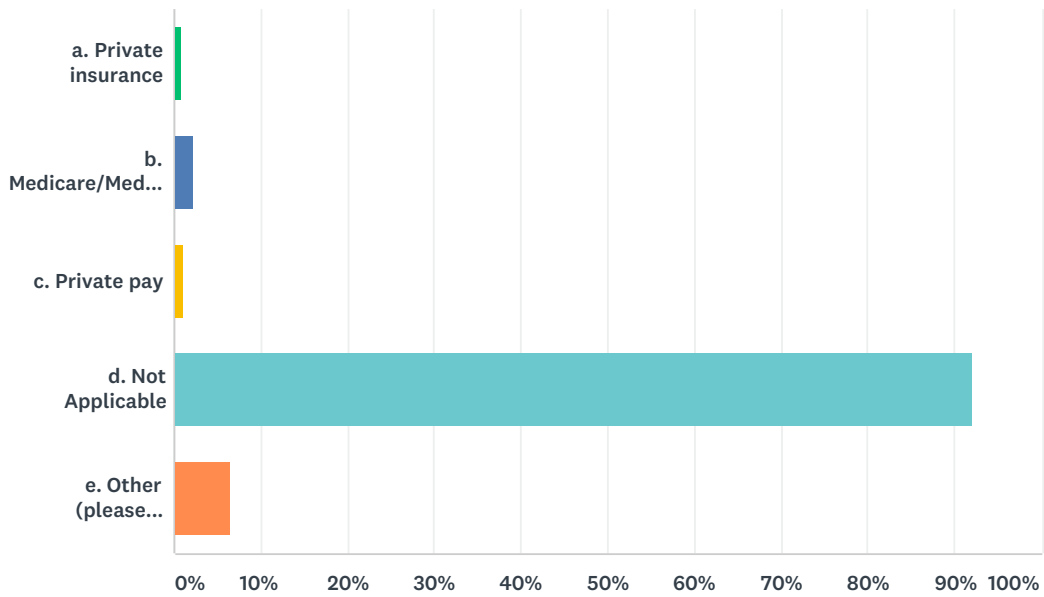

Q9 How are you reimbursed for telemedicine services? (Mark all that apply.)

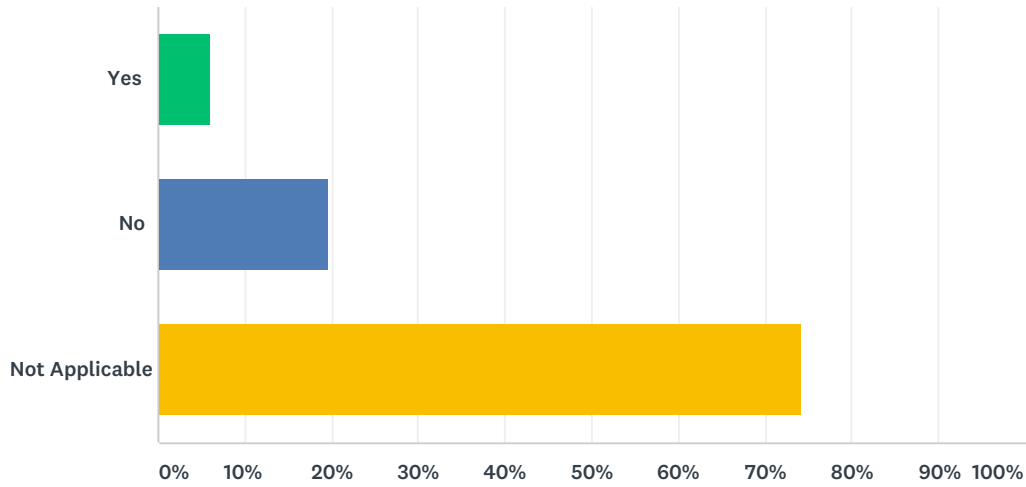

Q10 Are current laws impacting your ability to use telehealth as part of your service delivery model?

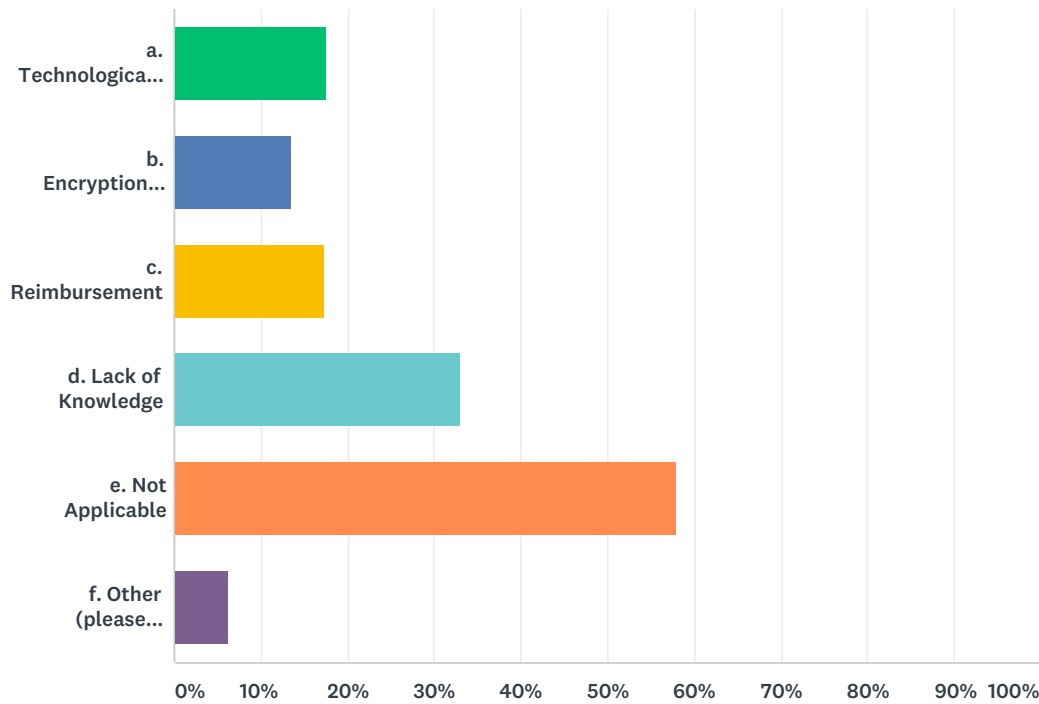

Q11 If you would like to include Telehealth within your practice, what are some of the barriers that prevent you from doing so? (Mark all that apply.)

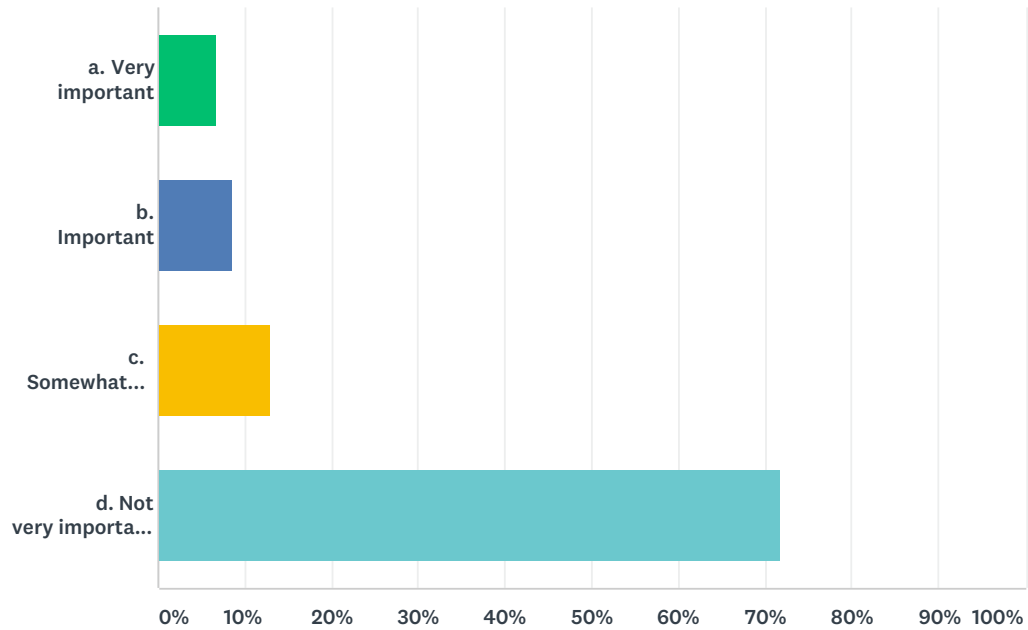
