

## Minutes

The Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on October 4, 2018, in accordance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this amended meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on August 13, 2018. Having noted a quorum, Ms. White called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

New committee members, Jennifer Wallace and April Tate, were welcomed to the Committee.

Barbara Smith, Executive Secretary, advised the Committee that longtime member, Troy Lee, OT, who is also the current vice-chair, has resigned effectively immediately. Mr. Lee was offered a promotion within his company which necessitates a move out of state. The Committee expressed its appreciation for the years of dedicated service Mr. Lee gave to Oklahoma's OT profession.

Following Committee discussion, Ms. Garza moved to table the election of Vice-Chair until the January 2019 committee meeting. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Then, the Committee heard from Robert Nisbet, MD, Coordinator, Oklahoma Allied Professional Peer Assistance Program (“APPA”). Dr. Nisbet explained that APPA is a voluntary program. APPA serves allied health professionals who have had substance abuse and/or behavioral issues and seek assistance. Dr. Nisbet stated that he has received no referrals from committee members and wanted to remind the committee that the APPA program is available. Members of the Committee were each provided an APPA brochure and Dr. Nisbet’s business card. Dr. Nisbet answered questions of the Committee and the Committee expressed its appreciation for the information.

The Committee then welcomed the visiting Occupational Therapy Assistant students from Oklahoma City Community College, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The floor was opened to the students for a question-and-answer session. The Committee and staff answered questions primarily regarding the application and licensure process. The students thanked the members for their time.

There being no further business, Ms. White adjourned the meeting. The time was 11:17 a.m.
