

Minutes

The Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on April 18, 2019, in accordance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Having noted a quorum, Ms. White called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Wallace moved to accept the minutes of January 24, 2019, as written. Ms. Arias seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JILLIAN GREGSTON appeared in support of her application for re-entry of Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure. Her Oklahoma licensed lapsed in 2013. She is licensed in other states (California, Missouri and Texas), however she had a past issue with the Texas Medical Board which she failed to disclose on her Oklahoma application. Mr. Schneider questioned the applicant and she confirmed that her Texas license was suspended for 60 calendar days and that suspension is no longer in effect, so her license in Texas is now reinstated. Her suspension in Texas was due to non-compliance with Texas continuing education requirements. Ms. Gregston advised she has a job offer in a skilled nursing facility and home health, and she has an Occupational Therapist willing to supervise her. The Committee is concerned with what they see as a pattern of behavior and wish to have a letter of no tolerance placed in her public file. Ms. Arias moved to recommend approval of the application of **JILLIAN GREGSTON** for re-entry of Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure pending completion of the file with a letter of no tolerance to be placed in her public file. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Ms. Rachel Herbert provided pre-reviewed continuing education units for the Committee's consideration. Ms. Wallace moved to approve the pre-approved continuing education units as presented. Ms. Arias seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. *(See Attachment #1)*

The Committee then had a discussion regarding OTs supervising more than four (4) OTAs. Ms. Cullen stated she needed guidance in this regard as it is very difficult for staff to track. Ms. White stated there are no hard and fast guidelines because these matters have been handled on a case-by-case basis. Setting specific guidelines in this regard will possibly require a rule change. Barbara Smith, Executive Secretary, confirmed with Mr. Schneider that the Committee has the authority to put guidelines for OTs supervising more than four (4) OTAs in its motion on a case-by-case basis. After further discussion, it was determined that Ms. Cullen will gather information regarding the OTs who are currently supervising more than four (4) OTAs and set personal appearances for July and October 2019, as appropriate. For the OT October 2019 appearance, Ms. Cullen will include language in the appearance letter similar to "failure to appear could affect your ability to continue to supervise OTAs."

In Ms. Garza's absence, Ms. White stated she had given some information to Ms. Garza regarding the actions Georgia has recently taken regarding telehealth. Reji Varghese, Deputy Director, advised that SB238 passed out of the House Committee and is on the House General Order and hopefully will be heard and approved. The deadline for hearing this bill is Thursday, April 25, 2019.

Ms. Smith asked the Committee to re-call the matter of **LORI KEISER**. Ms. Keiser did not appear in support of her application for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure. Ms. Arias tabled the application pending a personal appearance before the Committee. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Smith requested that, going forward, the Committee take up the personal appearances as they are listed on the agenda, rather than moving a no-show applicant to the bottom of the agenda. The Committee agreed on the process going forward.

The Occupational Therapy Assistant students, Oklahoma City Community College, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, were welcomed. The Committee answered questions regarding the application process and licensure. Mr. Schneider explained the difference between reciprocity and licensure by endorsement. The students thanked the committee members for their time.

There being no further business, Ms. Arias moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The time was 11:06 a.m.
