Having noted a quorum, Dr. Wallace called the meeting to order at 8:34 a.m.

Following Committee review, Mr. Hewett moved to approve the minutes of the February 13, 2017 meeting as written. Mr. Shero seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Joseph L. Ashbaker, Assistant Attorney General, and Rachel Rogers, Assistant Attorney General, appeared to present the allegations contained in the complaint styled *OSBMLS v. Gary Loveless, LPED, LPO*, and filed on September 11, 2017. Pursuant to law, Mr. Ashbaker requested a recommendation from the Committee regarding the discipline appropriate by the Oklahoma Medical Board in this matter assuming all allegations are proven as true and correct. Following Committee discussion, Mr. Shero moved to recommend to the Oklahoma Medical Board that they revoke the Licensed Podiatrist licensure of Gary Loveless, LPED, LPO. Mr. Hewett seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (See: *Title 59 O.S. §§ 2305.E.1.d and 2305.E.3.*)

Next, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Following Committee discussion, Mr. Shero moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application for reinstatement of **CINDY LYNN SMITH** for Licensed Pedorthist licensure pending completion of the file. Dr. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Hewett moved to recommend approval of the complete application of **JAMES BRADLEY DERAMUS** for Licensed Pedorthist licensure. Mr. Shero seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
