

Physical Therapy Advisory Committee
Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on February 12, 2016, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 1, 2015, and posted on the Board's website on February 10, 2016. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st St., Oklahoma City, OK on February 10, 2016 at 12:20 p.m.

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Craven called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

After Committee review, Mr. Haynes moved to approve the Minutes of December 11, 2015, as written. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

No public comments, oral or written, were received regarding the proposed revisions to the following rules:

MEGHAN ROARK, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person to advise the Committee of the circumstances surrounding her failure to complete double Continuing Education Units (“CEUs”) for the 2014-2015 compliance period. Ms. Roark did not complete the required CEUs for the 2012-2013 compliance period and she, therefore, was required to obtain double CEUs for the 2014-2015 cycle. While Ms. Roark obtained enough total CEUs to be in compliance, she did not have the required three hours of ethics. Ms. Roark presented proof to the Committee of the ethics hours she had just recently obtained. Mr. Titony moved to recommend requiring Ms. Roark to obtain double CEUs for the 2016-2017 compliance period due to her lack of completion of the previous requirement. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion. Upon discussion, the motion was amended as follows: Mr. Titony moved to recommend allowing Ms. Roark to renew her license and requiring her to obtain double CEUs for the 2016-2017 compliance period due to her lack of completion of the previous requirement. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

PAMELA JACKSON, Physical Therapist, appeared in person to advise the Committee of the circumstances surrounding her failure to complete double Continuing Education Units (“CEUs”) for the 2014-2015 compliance period. Ms. Mitchell informed the Committee that Ms. Jackson’s license had been renewed because she had completed her hours, albeit late. She stated she had taken several Institute for Natural Resources (“INR”) Category B courses which were approved for credit in Oklahoma. One of the courses she purchased was for three hours but, in fact, it was only approved for two hours. Ms. Jackson requested the Committee waive the requirement of obtaining double CEUs for this compliance period. Mr. Titony moved to recommend requiring Ms. Jackson to obtain double CEUs for this compliance period. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ERIC DARKIS, Physical Therapist, appeared in person to advise the Committee of the circumstances surrounding his failure to complete double Continuing Education Units (“CEUs”) for the 2014-2015 compliance period. Mr. Darkis did not complete the required hours for 2012-2013 and was required to obtain double CEUs for 2014-2015, but failed to do so. He stated he purchased the courses necessary to be compliant, but became ill. He has not been able to renew his license. Mr. Titony moved to recommend allowing Mr. Darkis to renew his license and requiring Mr. Darkis to obtain double CEUs for this compliance period. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

RONEE SHATSWELL, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person to advise the Committee of the circumstances surrounding her failure to complete double Continuing Education Units (“CEUs”) for the 2014-2015 compliance period. She has since completed the CEUs necessary to renew her license, but, unfortunately, the *CEU course she took has not yet been approved. If the Committee approves the course, then she could renew her license. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend allowing Ms. Shatswell to renew her license pending approval of the *CEU course and requiring her to obtain double CEUs for this compliance period. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

RENEE MOLSKNESS, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person to advise the Committee of the circumstances surrounding her failure to complete the Continuing Education Units (“CEUs”) required for the 2014-2015 compliance period. She currently lacks nine (9)

Category A hours and, as such, her license has not been renewed. She stated her CEUs were not completed due to financial hardship; however she is enrolled in two courses next week that will provide ten (10) CEUs. She is completely willing to obtain double CEUs for this compliance period. Mr. Titony moved to recommend renewing her license pending completion of nine (9) hours of CEU and requiring her to complete double CEUs for this compliance period. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JOHN HELFRICH, applicant, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person in support of his application and requesting a waiver of education due to his completion of the Physical Therapy Aide program in the Army. He is currently licensed as a PTA in Arkansas. He sat for the Federation of State Board of Physical Therapy (“FSBPT”) certification exam in 1999 and received a passing score for Oklahoma licensure. Mr. Titony moved to recommend approval of Mr. Helfrich for Physical Therapy Assistant licensure by endorsement based on his Arkansas license. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DOMINIQUE RUSS, applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared in person to request that the Committee sponsor her appeal to FSBPT to sit for the certification test for a tenth time. If the Committee agrees to sponsor her appeal, she would also request she be allowed to sit for the exam a third time in Oklahoma and with special accommodations. Ms. Russ stated she has completed the appeal form, but it is required that she be sponsored by a state board/committee. Her plan is to work with a professor at the university in addition to studying five days a week on didactic and clinical components. She advised that she has received special accommodations before and she feels like she has anxiety over failing the test rather than anxiety over the subject matter. Her last several test scores were within two (2) points of passing. The Committee advised her to focus on passing the exam and her base of knowledge. Mr. Titony moved that the Physical Therapy Advisory Committee of the Oklahoma Medical Board of Licensure and Supervision sponsor her appeal to the FSBPT to sit for the certification exam a final time. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Upon further discussion of the Committee, Mr. Haynes moved to recommend allowing Ms. Russ to sit for the exam a third time in Oklahoma with special testing accommodations of double time and a separate testing room, as requested. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ANTHONY WELLS, applicant, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person in support of his request to sit for the certification exam a third time. He stated he has purchased a study book with DVDs and he will purchase the Practice Exam and Assessment Tool (“PEAT”) offered by FSBPT. The Committee recommended he get in touch with his previous instructors/professors for assistance with studying. Mr. Titony recommended he spend some time in an acute care setting or rehab hospital to broaden his knowledge base. The Committee felt like April of 2016 was too soon for him to re-take the test and advised Mr. Wells that they would like to see his plan of study. Mr. Titony moved to recommend tabling the request with a personal appearance and presentation of plan of study at the meeting on April 15, 2016. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JEFFREY JAMES, applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared in person to request to sit for the certification exam the first time with special accommodations. He will graduate in May

of 2016. After review of his paperwork, the Committee commended Mr. James for being proactive. Mr. Titony moved to recommend allowing Mr. James special testing accommodations of time and a half and a separate room, as requested, when he sits for the exam the first time. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for Physical Therapist licensure. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

After Committee review, Ms. Davis recommended approval of the CEU courses previously reviewed and recommended for approval by reviewers up to this date. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (*See Attachment # 1 - Need complete list from Licensing to attach hereto*)

*After Committee review, Mr. Titony moved to recommend approval of the course submitted by Ronnie Shatswell, *Mobilizing the Medically Complex ICU and Acute Care Patient (an Evidence-Based Model)*, for 15 contact hours (1.5 CEUs). Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (*See Attachment # 2*)

After Committee discussion, Mr. Titony moved to add Nancy Davis, Physical Therapy Assistant, as a member to the Continuing Competence Subcommittee. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

After Committee discussion, Mr. Titony moved to *remove* David Haynes, Physical Therapist, and *add* Mitsy Martin-Davis; Eddie Traylor; Jennifer Ball; Bri Johns; and Jennifer Turner to the Continuing Education Review Subcommittee.

And finally, the Committee heard from Reji Varghese, Deputy Director, who reported he has met with the I.T. and web teams and they have devised a plan to avoid the “firestorm” licensing staff went through recently with CEU approvals. Mr. Varghese stated there is one dedicated web program for this project, but due to other responsibilities, he is only able to work part-time. Mr. Varghese presented a summary of the plan (*attached*) for Committee review and stated that, hopefully, it will be completed by the end of April, 2016. Mr. Titony requested that there be a place to designate for what compliance period the courses are being submitted, and also he would like an auto-fill feature for course providers, i.e., “OU,” “OUHSC,” “University of Oklahoma,” etc. Mr. Titony would also like for the Committee to discuss, at some point, the possibility of approving a course for a longer period of time than one compliance period. Mr. Varghese stated that could be done electronically, but the approval is done through the Committee at the Committee level. Ms. Craven wants the word “Approver” to be replaced with “Reviewer” on the portal. Ms. Craven stated she likes the option of “self-selection” for the course reviewers in deciding which courses they would review. Ms. Craven advised she would email the list of committee members as well as a comprehensive list of specialties to Mr. Varghese. Mr. Varghese brought up the issue of a rule change regarding the final date in the compliance period for Licensing to accept CEUs for credit. Discussion regarding a possible rule change will be put on the August 2016 Agenda. (*See Attachment # 3*)

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The time was 11:19 a.m.
