

Physical Therapy Advisory Committee
Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on April 15, 2016, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 1, 2015, and posted on the Board's website on April 13, 2016. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma on April 13, 2016 at 9:15 a.m.

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Craven called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

After Committee review, Mr. Haynes moved to approve the Minutes of February 12, 2016 as written. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Mr. Reji Varghese reported on the status of the two-phase project for the continuing education unit ("CEU") online reporting and reviewing system. The first phase is a submittal portal through which vendors and licensees may electronically submit CEUs for review/approval. Mr. Varghese indicated the first phase is relatively easy. The second phase is the reviewer's portal which has a lot of moving parts and is quite a bit more complex. Mr. Varghese led the Committee through a demonstration of the submittal portal which is currently in the testing phase. Mr. Varghese emphasized that this is still a work-in-progress. He indicated that once the CEUs are submitted electronically, Licensing Staff will populate an Excel spreadsheet for Committee review. This process will make it much easier for the Staff and Committee. Mr. Varghese anticipates that the submittal portal will go live at the end of this month or the first part of May, 2016. He hopes for the reviewer portal to go live sometime in

August of 2016. Mr. Varghese also has plans for this same electronic submission process to be available for Respiratory Care and Occupational Therapy licensees and that is why the progress is moving a little slower than initially anticipated. The Committee asked if there is a size limit on the documentation that can be submitted. Mr. Varghese stated he will get with the IT group and determine if there will be a size limit. The Committee was very appreciative of and impressed with the work Mr. Varghese and the IT group have done in this regard. (*This demonstration was conducted electronically on the screens in the Board Room and a handout was not provided.*)

*The Committee then called the matter of **ANTHONY WELLS**, applicant for Physical Therapist licensure. Mr. Wells was not present so the Committee moved on to the next Agenda Item and took no action at this time.

GINA DILLARD appeared in support of her request for special accommodations when sitting for the national certification exam. Ms. Dillard previously requested, and was awarded, special accommodations for school/college exams. Mr. Titony moved to recommend allowing Ms. Gina Dillard special accommodations as requested when sitting for the national certification exam. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DANIEL SANTIAGO appeared in support of his request for special accommodations when sitting for the national certification exam. Mr. Santiago requested double-time to complete the exam. He stated that he received special accommodations through school and also was awarded extra time when he sat for the ACT national test. Mr. Titony moved to recommend allowing special accommodations as requested for the national certification exam. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DUSTIN RHODES appeared in support of his application for Physical Therapy Assistant licensure. Following Committee review and discussion, Mr. Titony moved to approve the application pending completion of the file. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JONATHAN MILLER appeared in support of his application for reinstatement of Physical Therapist licensure. He is currently licensed in California. Mr. Miller answered questions of the Committee regarding past disciplinary action in California. Mr. Varghese confirmed that Applicant has met with Board Secretary and the director of Allied Professionals Peer Assistance Program and they are in the process of drafting a proposed agreement for licensure that mirrors the terms of the California disciplinary action. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend approval of the application for reinstatement under terms of agreement pending completion of the file. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

RAIZA SAMKUTTY appeared in support of her application for Physical Therapist licensure and her request for the Committee to review the report from the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy ("FCCPT"). Ms. Samkutty stated that she

graduated in 2015 from Physical Therapy school in England and is currently licensed in England. She has seven years of university study and does not agree with the FCCPT report that her education is lacking due to the fact that she does not have a doctorate or master's degree. She has not yet sat for the national certification exam. The Committee advised her that it was the content of the courses taken, not the time spent, that was not substantially equivalent to the education requirements for Oklahoma licensure. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend tabling the application pending Applicant obtaining additional courses as recommended by the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy and then resubmitting those courses through the coursework tool of the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

REGINALD SMITH appeared in support of his application for Physical Therapy Assistant licensure. Mr. Smith is currently working on the Army base in Lawton, but will retire in two months and hopes to go into private practice. The Physical Therapy Aide training he received in the military is not nationally accredited. The Committee advised he could complete the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy coursework tool to ensure substantial educational equivalency, per the Oklahoma practice act which states at 887.6:B(2) "that the education of the applicant is substantially equivalent to, or exceeds, the requirements of accredited educational program." Mr. Titony stated he obtained Physical Therapy Assistant licensure from another state, he would be eligible for licensure by endorsement in Oklahoma. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend tabling the application pending completion of the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy coursework tool to determine equivalency of education, a personal appearance before the Committee, and pending completion of the file. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

RICARDO VILLARREL, Physical Therapy Assistant, appeared in person regarding his failure to complete the required double continuing education units for the 2014-2015 reporting period. Mr. Titony stated for the record that he and Mr. Villarrel know each other, but he does not have an issue reviewing the matter before him. Mr. Villarrel confirmed that he has no issue with Mr. Titony reviewing the matter at hand. Mr. Villarrel currently lacks seven (7) hours of Category "A" credit in order to complete the required double hours. After further review and discussion, Mr. Titony moved to allow Ricardo Villarrel to renew his license pending the completion of his required double continuing education units for the 2014-2015 compliance period and to be required to obtain double continuing education units for the 2016-2017 compliance period. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

FRANK BURTON, Physical Therapist, appeared in support of his request to supervise a fourth Physical Therapy Assistant. Mr. Burton stated he currently supervises three PTAs, one of whom is his wife who currently stays home with their twin children. The Committee advised Mr. Burton it would be beneficial for him to find another Physical Therapist in his rural community who would be willing to form a group for PTA supervision purposes. After further review and discussion, Mr. Titony moved to deny the request of Mr. Burton to supervise a

fourth Physical Therapy Assistant. Mr. Haynes seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

*The Committee again called the matter of **ANTHONY WELLS**, applicant, Physical Therapist licensure. Mr. Wells did not appear in support of his application and his request to sit for the certification exam a third time. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend tabling the application pending Mr. Wells making a personal appearance with required supporting documentation. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Haynes moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for Physical Therapist licensure. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The committee then reviewed continuing education units submitted for approval. Ms. Davis moved to grant the request of Mr. Haynes to be removed from the Continuing Competency Subcommittee. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee directed Ms. Barbara Smith to add Ms. Mitsy Martin-Davis to the Continuing Competency Subcommittee.

Next the Committee considered a request to reschedule the August 2016 Committee meeting. Mr. Haynes moved to reschedule the meeting set for August 12th to August 19, 2016. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee directed Ms. Barbara Smith to make the necessary arrangements required for rescheduling a meeting.

Next the Committee discussed members attending national conferences that are all-expenses paid by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy. Mr. Varghese stated that all travel, regardless of who funds the travel, must be submitted to the cabinet secretary per executive order of the governor. His experience has been that the state is not approving more than one person to attend a conference. Mr. Varghese stated that Executive Staff has concluded that they do not want Staff to travel. Mr. Varghese provided a travel request/worksheet to be filled out by Committee members who are requesting travel. He further advised the Committee against making any travel plans until approval has been secured. After discussion, Mr. Haynes moved to recommend Ms. Mitsy Martin-Davis for attendance at Board Member Training sponsored and funded by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy in Alexandria, Virginia, on June 25-26, 2016. Mr. Titony seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (**Attachment #2**)

The Committee directed Ms. Barbara Smith to register Ms. Davis with the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy for attendance at this seminar.

Mr. Titony moved to recommend Mr. David Haynes for attendance at the Leadership Issues Forum sponsored and funded by the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy in Alexandria, Virginia on July 30-31, 2016. Ms. Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee directed Ms. Barbara Smith to register Mr. Haynes with the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy for attendance at this seminar.

The Committee directed Ms. Barbara Smith to place attendance at the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Annual Meeting, which is scheduled to take place in November of 2016 in Ohio, as an action item on the Committee's June 2016 Agenda.

The Committee revisited the issue of Physical Therapists requesting to supervise a fourth Physical Therapy Assistant and, again, agreed and confirmed it is considered by the Committee to be an "employment issue."

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned. The time was 10:32 a.m.
