

Physical Therapy Advisory Committee

Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on January 25, 2019, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 10, 2018, and posted on the Board's website on January 22, 2019 at 2:36 p.m. in accordance with 25 O.S. § 311.9.

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Hinkle, acting chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Berry moved to approve the minutes of the December 7, 2018, meeting as written. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Ginger Schirmer, CE International, appeared to discuss the approval, tabling and/or denial of continuing education courses presented by CE International. Ms. Schirmer stated some of the courses "A" version are being approved, but the "B" version which is exactly the same as the "A" version with same speakers and courses, are being denied. She stated that the "B" version is usually a recording of the "A" version. She was confused about why these denials were occurring. Further, she went through the credentials of the presenters as well as how the previously denied courses do, in fact, directly relate to the practice of PT. She stated that none of the courses are introductory, they are all intermediate level. Further, Ms. Schirmer strongly disagrees with disapproval of the courses Woman and Autoimmune Disease, which physical

therapists treat, and the Leaky Gut which speaks to healing from the inside out. In closing, she stated that education should not be narrowed to the scope of clinical practice only.

Ms. Carla Hinkle stated the Committee does not doubt Ms. Schirmer's qualifications in her field and she has great respect for her education in her area. There are often reasons why a Category "B" might be approved but the subcommittee might not approve a Category "A" if certain things are not clear. It might be just a matter of needing clarification. Ms. Hinkle stated that the changing dates of the courses is an issue for the subcommittee because the rules specifically state that there must be a date for the course. Regarding approving CE International courses, the subcommittees have to follow the administrative code for specific items and one of those requirements is found in *Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-9-3(c)* which states a course must be sufficient to provide evaluation of relevance to the field of PT. Nutritional and diet supplementation without a course objective are typically denied because dietary counseling or nutritional background is outside the scope of PT and it would be improper for that to be approved as defined by the PT Act and Administrative Code. Ms. Hinkle advised that even though it is wonderful information and would be of benefit, that does not mean it qualifies under the continuing education in the rules as it applies to PT.

Ms. Schirmer stated that in 2014-2015 essentially all courses were approved as well as in 2016-2017. Ms. Berry stated the rules have not changed, but the previous reviewers may not have been reviewing the courses to the letter of the rules. Ms. Berry stated more prompts should be added to the reviewer page when courses are being reviewed.

Ms. Schirmer stated she is more than happy to fill in objectives for courses that were previously denied or tabled for resubmission. The CEU review subcommittee meets again on February 21, 2019. Ms. Schirmer will submit to Rachel Herbert, no later than Monday, January 28, 2019, a list of what she needs to have reviewed quickly and Rachel will get that list to the review subcommittee.

Regarding the next discussion item on the agenda, CEU approval by subcommittee for approving, tabling and denying, Ms. Hinkle stated there is an active subcommittee for the approval process and they closely follow the rules, particularly for Category "A" courses. The subcommittee walks a fine line and does not want to be more restrictive or more lenient than what the rules allow.

Barbara Smith, Executive Secretary, requested that the agenda be re-ordered to next consider the licensee who is appearing via web video. Ms. Hinkle granted permission to re-order the agenda.

PERNILLE SANDERS appeared via web video in support of her request for exception to the continuing education requirements pursuant to *Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-9-3(a)(3)(4)*. She is currently located in Norway but she would like to maintain her Oklahoma license so that she may practice when she returns to Oklahoma. She stated she has not worked more than 250 hours this year. Ms. Hinkle explained there does not appear to be any significant deterrent to Ms. Sanders obtaining all the CEU hours as required. She advised that physical restrictions such as illness or hospitalization are considered deterrents, but not geographics/logistics.

Ms. Berry moved to deny the request for an exception in continuing education requirements pursuant to *Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-9-3(a)(3)(4)*. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

CANDI SPEARS appeared in support of her application for re-entry of Physical Therapist Assistant licensure. She last practiced in 2014. She is not currently licensed in another state and her license lapsed on January 31, 2015. Ms. Spears stated she had worked at an outpatient facility for 15 years. Due to familial issues (adopted children with traumatic backgrounds) and financial issues (she home schooled the children), she chose to let her license lapse due to high cost of CEUs. Her children are now attending public school and she needs to provide for her children. She has enrolled in Summit Professional education online and has been in touch with two PTs who are willing to work with her.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend approving the application of **CANDI SPEARS** for re-entry of Physical Therapist Assistant licensure pending completion of the file to include obtaining four (4) months of direct, on-site supervision with a report from her supervisor to be provided for staff review, and obtaining 120 continuing education hours not to include the 30 hours due in the current compliance period. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KODIE PRICE, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination for a third time. Ms. Price presented a study plan for Committee review. She advised the Committee that she is a student completing her Bachelor's degree and holding down two part-time jobs as well. Ms. Price advised that she has taken practice exams and will also review the FSBPT Practice Examination & Assessment Tool ("PEAT") before her licensure examination. She also has several mentors who are assisting with review.

Mr. Ward moved to recommend allowing **KODIE PRICE** to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

MARY KEYS, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination for a third time. She attended a PTA program in Tulsa and graduated in 1999. She was unsuccessful when she sat for the exams the first two times and soon after she started a family. She chose to stay home and raise her children. She coached basketball at the collegiate level and wants to get back to what she loves, practicing as a PTA. She has been working as a tech for about 18 months and has been studying since November. The applicant provided a study plan for Committee review. She advised she has a mentor who is helping her with study and review and she anticipates sitting for the exam on April 4, 2019.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend allowing **MARY KEYS** to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

*****STACEY SPRINGER**, Physical Therapist Assistant, did not appear in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time. The Committee took no action on this matter at this time.

SYDNEY HAMILTON, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination for a third time. Ms. Hamilton stated that she has had difficulties studying and has had family issues during

the past two exams. Additionally, she believes she has test anxiety. She has not yet purchased the performance feedback report due to lack of funds, but feels that her weaknesses are in the areas of musculoskeletal and neuro. She has spoken with the Carl Albert Program director and she can go back and review classes if she finds that to be necessary. The applicant has a PT mentor who has offered to assist her with study and review. She is working through study books as well, but did not provide a written study plan for Committee review.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend allowing **SYDNEY HAMILTON** to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DEVAN SHAHAN, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination for a third time. Ms. Shahan presented her study plan to the Committee and advised that she has four mentors in place. She has access to all of her collegiate videos and she has purchased an FSBPT Practice Examination & Assessment Tool ("PEAT") review book and also has the Scorebuilders PTA exam. Ms. Shahan is attending a course review in Houston, Texas and is studying on three phone apps as well. Ms. Shahan advised that she had some medical issues which is why her second examination score was lower than her first exam. She believes that musculoskeletal and cardio are her weak areas and she has locations set up where she can "shadow". Ms. Shahan is also participating in "Base Camp" in February and March of 2019 through Score Builders, which is a study program that thoroughly breaks down each subject.

Mr. Ward moved to recommend allowing **DEVAN SHAHAN** to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

MEGAN MATTOX, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared in support of her request for special accommodations for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination of time and a half and a private room. She has been provided special accommodations through college for anxiety and she is currently scheduled to graduate in May.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend allowing **MEGAN MATTOX** special accommodations of time and a half and a private testing room when she sits for the Federation of State Board of Physical Therapy Examination. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

***The Committee again called the matter of **STACEY SPRINGER**, Physical Therapist Assistant. Ms. Springer did not appear in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") Examination for a third time. Mr. Ward moved to table the request of **STACEY SPRINGER** to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy Examination for a third time pending a personal appearance before the Committee. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JOSHUA UTT, Physical Therapist, appeared in support of his request for an extension of the 80-hour continuing education unit ("CEU") requirement deadline set forth by the Committee on February 16, 2018. Mr. Utt provided information for Committee review. His license expired in 2017 while he was in rehab for substance abuse. He was released in May of 2017 and has been attempting to obtain licensure since that time. He continued to run up against

"a licensing wall" but finally had everything in order to obtain licensure in October of 2018. At that time, he was told that the former employee he had been dealing with was let go and he had been given incorrect information from her.

He has had a very difficult time finding CEUs. He asked for an extension of the CEU deadline and now that it is January, new CEU courses are available again for him to take. He is just a few hours short of the 80-hour requirement. He has two courses set up for next week for five hours which will give him the 80 hours of CEUs which he needs. He previously submitted 40 CEU hours prior to the deadline and those have all been approved. The other 35 hours he has submitted are under review for approval.

Ms. Berry moved that the request of **JOSHUA UTT** for an extension of the deadline to obtain 40 continuing education units be granted until the end of the current compliance period. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion. Following discussion, Ms. Hincke withdrew her motion.

Ms. Hincke moved that the request of **JOSHUA UTT** for an extension of the deadline to obtain 40 continuing education units be granted until February 28, 2019. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

It was announced that the matter of **RICARDO VILLARREL, PTA**, will be presented to the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision. Mr. Villarreal was not present and the Committee took no action on this matter.

*The Committee took a brief five-minute recess.

*Meeting resumed.

The Committee then reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Ward moved to recommend approval of the following incomplete applications for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure pending completion of the files. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee then discussed the Newsletter. Ms. Hinkle recommended the previous newsletter concept be revived in electronic format for the purpose of keeping licensees informed.

Ms. Berry moved that a standing item be placed on each agenda to review and discuss topics for an electronic newsletter for dissemination of information to licensees on a regular basis. Mr. Ward seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Mike Sulzyucki volunteered to assist in the composition of the newsletter. Ms. Berry suggested the newsletter could be disseminated approximately two weeks following each committee meeting, posted on the website and emailed to all licensees. Newsletter submissions should be forwarded to the committee chair and then to appropriate staff member for dissemination. Possible topics recommended include: emeritus status, the difference between OPTA and PT Advisory Committee, rule interpretations such as practicing with a temporary letter when the law says you cannot, clarification of group supervision, clarification of category "A" and "B" CEU courses, and keeping contact information updated with the Medical Board. The first newsletter priorities should include the life-cycle of continuing education and function of the advisory committee versus the OPTA, i.e., the differences between the two, and share with colleagues to help ensure contact information gets updated for all licensees to ensure everyone receives the newsletter.

There being no further business, Mr. Ward moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The time was 11:40 a.m.
