

Minutes

The Respiratory Care Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on January 26, 2017. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 1, 2016, and posted on the Board's website on January 24, 2017. The notice and agenda were posted in prominent public view on the front doors of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision building located at 101 NE 51st St., Oklahoma City, OK on January 24, 2017 at 12:45 p.m.

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Porterfield called the meeting to order at 11:30 a.m.

Following Committee review, Dr. Royder moved to approve the October 20, 2016, minutes as written. Dr. Fixley seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Following Committee discussion, and in compliance with *Title 59 Okla. Stat. § 2029*, Dr. Royder nominated Jim Porterfield, RCP, and Vickie Nation, RCP, to each serve an additional term as Chair and Vice-Chair of the Committee respectively. There being no further nominations, a vote was held and was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, **GABRIELA CALDERON** appeared via web video in support of her complete application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. She passed the National Board of Respiratory Care exam at the CRT level in January of 2015 and subsequently graduated in April of 2016. She has not practiced since graduation. Ms. Calderon stated that when she graduated, she had an infant and decided to stay at home until her baby was one-year old. She also has recently relocated to Oklahoma from Florida. She stated she has completed 4.4 hours of continuing education just recently and has a position at St. Francis Hospital in Tulsa, Oklahoma, if she can obtain licensure. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application with completion of one month of direct supervision. Dr. Fixley seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DEBORAH GIAIMO appeared in support of her application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. She graduated in December of 2013 and her application is complete. Applicant also holds active Texas and Arizona licenses with valid CRT and RRT. Applicant also brought with her documentation of 54 continuing education units for Committee review. She has not practiced and she stated that is due to traveling with her husband. She currently lives in Denton, Texas, but hopes to relocate to Oklahoma. Sally Crites, her potential supervisor in Durant, Oklahoma, appeared in support of Applicant. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Mr. Moss seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

EVA HOWELL appeared in support of her application for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure under re-entry guidelines. Her Oklahoma license expired in April of 2009 and her CRT is valid indefinitely. Her Texas license expired in 2006 and her last date of practice was June of 2006. She has provided documentation of 12 continuing education units she obtained in the last month. She would like to return to work full-time this summer and would probably work in the Tulsa area. Ms. Howell stated she has not looked into a job where she would have supervision and training because she did not know what would initially be required of her; however, she would not be comfortable working without supervision and training. Because her license expired in 2009, seven months (one month for each year a license is lapsed) of direct supervision is required. The Committee explained that "direct supervision" means someone has to be on-site at all times but not necessarily in the room once competencies have been checked off, but that she cannot go off-site without someone being present. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of her application for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure under re-entry guidelines based on her appearance before the Committee, obtaining seven months of direct supervision, and obtaining a total of forty-eight (48) continuing education units. Ms. Nation seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KARA POLITO did not appear in support of her application for Respiratory Care licensure. Ms. Nation moved to recommend tabling the application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Ms. Beard seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Following Committee review, Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for reinstatement of Respiratory Care licensure. Dr. Royder seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
