

Minutes

The Respiratory Care Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on November 15, 2018. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 10, 2017. The notice and agenda were posted on the Board's website on November 13, 2018 at 11:31 a.m. in compliance with 25 O.S. § 311.9.

Having noted a quorum, Clayton Royder, MD, (Acting Chair), called the meeting to order at 11:32 a.m.

Following Committee review, Mr. Grantz moved to accept the minutes of August 23, 2018, as written. Mr. Grantz seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

STACY CHARPENTIER appeared in support of her application for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Ms. Cullen advised the Committee that the applicant last practiced in 2016 and her Oklahoma license lapsed in 2017. She is currently not licensed in another state but is registered through the National Board for Respiratory Care. The applicant stated that her license lapsed on accident. She is currently working as realtor, but has kept up with her continuing education unit (CEU) requirements and she brought proof of 13 courses for

Committee review. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application of **STACY CHARPENTIER** for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure based on her personal appearance before the Committee and presentation of continuing education units. Ms. Beard seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KARLA WELLS appeared in support of her application for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Ms. Cullen advised the Committee that the applicant last practiced in June of 2014 and is not currently licensed in another state. Her Oklahoma license lapsed June of 2018. She is current through the National Board for Respiratory Care. The applicant advised the Committee that she has been working at Tinker Air Force Base, but not in the field of respiratory care. She stated that she has maintained her continuing education units ("CEUs"). Currently she has 30.5 CEUs which she provided for Committee review. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application of **KARLA WELLS** for reinstatement of Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure based on her personal appearance before the Committee and pending verification of the continuing education units presented. Ms. Tenney seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

EURADELL DAVIS appeared in support of her application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Ms. Davis originally appeared before the Committee in February of 2015 at which time the Committee recommended she be approved for licensure "*pending satisfactorily completing the NBRC certification exam and satisfactorily completing 90 days of practice under direct supervision.*" Because Ms. Davis was unable to meet the recommendations, in March of 2016 her application went into "no response." In July of 2018 the applicant advised licensing staff she is now able to meet the recommendations of the Committee, however, due to the length of time that had passed since her initial Committee appearance, she was requested to appear before the Committee today.

Ms. Davis apologized for not completing what was required of her and stated it was due to family illness. In the interim, Ms. Davis worked for AT&T through April of this year and completed her Master's degree in Business Administration. She has maintained her continuing education units and re-took Kettering Comprehensive Respiratory Care Seminar in August of this year. She is currently employed with American Medical as a customer service representative and she is hoping to work there as a respiratory therapist once licensed. She attempted the re-certification exam and failed by 12 points. Her application is incomplete at this time.

Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application of **EURADELL DAVIS** for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure based on personal appearance pending completion of the file to include completing the recommendations from February of 2015 which are "*pending satisfactorily completing the NBRC certification exam and satisfactorily completing 90 days of practice under direct supervision.*" Ms. Beard seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JERRI STEWART appeared in support of her application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. Ms. Cullen advised the Committee that the applicant last practiced in 2012. Her Texas license expired in 2017. She is not currently licensed in any other state and has never

been licensed in Oklahoma. In 2012 she left her job as director of the cardiopulmonary unit at Baylor Medical Center in Plano, Texas. She then went back to school and served in different capacities as a volunteer. She recently applied for a job with Alliance Hospital, Durant, Oklahoma, where she will work under a preceptor for at least 90 days. She has maintained all required continuing education units ("CEUs") through September of 2017. She is current on Basic Life Support ("BLS") and has taken the written exam for the ventilator. She has also passed the National Board for Respiratory Care examination. Her application is incomplete. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application of **JERRI STEWART** for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure based on her appearance before the Committee and pending completion of the file including passing the National Board for Respiratory Care exam at the CRT level and obtaining 90 days of direct on-site supervision with a report from her supervisor provided for Committee review. Mr. Moss seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JERRY ROBERSON appeared in support of his application for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure. His last practice as a respiratory care practitioner was in 2011 and he has not been licensed in Oklahoma. He completed his master's and doctorate program and has taught respiratory care for many years at the collegiate level. He is licensed in Texas and California and is currently teaching respiratory care under AMI in California. He has moved to Oklahoma due to a family health crisis and intends to teach at the collegiate level here. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the application of **JERRY ROBERSON** for Respiratory Care Practitioner licensure based on his appearance before the Committee and previously passing the National Board for Respiratory Care exam at the CRT level. Ms. Beard seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Grantz moved to recommend approval of the following incomplete Provisional Respiratory Therapist applications pending completion of the files. Ms. Beard seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
