Chapter 11 – COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency Rules**

**435:11-1-12 Temporary Licensure Following Expiration of COVID-19 Declared
Emergency**

All out-of-state physicians, surgeons, and physician assistants possessing a critical need license at the time of the expiration or withdrawal of the Governor’s emergency declaration under Second Amended Executive Order 2021-07 may continue to practice in the State of Oklahoma under a temporary, restricted license by the Oklahoma State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision for a period not to exceed one hundred and fifty (150) days to allow for the physician, surgeon, or physician assistant sufficient time to apply for full or unrestricted licensure, or to transition any patients back to in-person examination and treatment.
