\_\_\_ **\*WILSON BERNALES, MD** – Disciplinary hearing based on allegations of disciplinary action of another state or jurisdiction against a license or other authorization to practice medicine and surgery based upon acts of conduct by the licensee similar to acts or conduct that would constitute grounds for action as defined in this section, a certified copy of the record of the action taken by the other state or jurisdiction being conclusive evidence thereof; being physically or mentally unable to practice medicine and surgery with reasonable skill and safety; and practice or other behavior that demonstrates an incapacity or incompetence to practice medicine and surgery.

\_\_\_ **\*MELISSA FLAMING FORD, PTA** - Disciplinary hearing based on allegations of habitual intemperance or the habitual use of habit-forming drugs; felony conviction that poses a reasonable threat to public safety; habitual intemperance or addicted use

of any drug, chemical or substance that could result in behavior that interferes with the practice of physical therapy and the responsibilities of the licensee; guilty of conduct unbecoming a person licensed as a physical therapist assistant or guilty of conduct detrimental to the best interests of the public or the profession; and guilty of any act in conflict with the ethics of the profession of physical therapy.

\_\_\_ **\*DARRYL DERMOT ROBINSON, MD** – Disciplinary hearing based on allegations of prescribing, selling, administering, distributing, ordering, or giving any drug legally classified as a controlled substance or recognized as an addictive dangerous drug to a family member or to himself or herself (provided that this paragraph shall not apply to family members outside the second degree of consanguinity or affinity and provided further that this paragraph shall not apply to medical emergencies when no other doctor is available to respond to the emergency); and violating any state or federal law or regulation relating to controlled substances.
