

## Minutes

The Occupational Therapy Advisory Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on July 14, 2022, in accordance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this regular meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 15, 2021. The notice and agenda were posted on the Board's website on July 6, 2022, at 11:24 a.m. pursuant to 25 O.S. § 311(A)(9).

Having noted a quorum, Ms. White, Acting Chair, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Garza moved to accept the meeting minutes of April 21, 2022, as written. Ms. Gorman seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The Committee next considered nominations for Committee Chair and Vice-Chair pursuant to Okla. Admin. Code 435:30-1-9. Ms. Garza nominated Ms. White to serve as Chair and Ms. White politely declined the nomination. Ms. White nominated Ms. Garza to serve as Chair and Ms. Garza politely declined the nomination. Ms. White nominated Ms. Gorman to serve as Chair and, after discussion, Ms. Gorman accepted the nomination. Ms. Garza seconded the nomination and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. Ms. Garza nominated Ms. Wallace to serve as Vice-Chair and Ms. Wallace accepted the nomination. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**DAVID TURNBULL** appeared virtually in support of his application for Occupational Therapist licensure. He has never practiced and he was certified in 2018. His certification is set to expire in March of 2024 and Mr. Turnbull is not licensed in any other state. Mr. Turnbull stated he earned his Ph.D in occupational science and graduated that program in December 2021. Following discussion, Ms. Gorman moved to recommend approval of the application for licensure. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**TAMMY THOMPSON, OT**, did not appear in support of her request to supervise more than four (4) Occupational Therapy Assistants. Ms. Garza moved to table this request pending receipt of requested information. Ms. Gorman seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**KRISTIN VOSKUHL, OT**, appeared virtually in support of her request to supervise more than four (4) Occupational Therapy Assistants. Ms. Voskuhl advised that an additional OT is being hired but she will not be licensed in Oklahoma until November, 2022. Ms. Wallace moved to recommend granting the request to allow Ms. Voskuhl to supervise up to five supervisees which are Kimberly Wood, OTA, Karen Martin, OTA, Brittny Banks, OT, Grace Graziano, OT, and Erin Purnell, OT, until the November 17, 2022, Medical Board meeting. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza issued a staff directive to the Licensing Department to add credentials and years of practice to the OT supervision form for those OTs supervising more than four supervisees. Lisa Cullen will email a copy of the revised form to the committee members individually for their review.

The Committee then reviewed applications for licensure. Ms. Smith discussed with the Committee a suggested change in motion procedure going forward. The Committee was receptive to streamlining the motions made during the application recommendation process.

Ms. Garza moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications as indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure pending completion of the files. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza moved to recommend approval of the complete applications indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure. Ms. Gorman seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto for Occupational Therapist licensure pending completion of the files. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application for reinstatement indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto of Occupational Therapist licensure pending completion of the file. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza moved to recommend approval of the complete applications indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto for Occupational Therapist licensure. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Valeska Barr presented courses previously recommended for approval by the subcommittee. Ms. Wallace moved to recommend approval of the CEU courses indicated on *Attachment #2* hereto which were previously recommended for approval. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Barr then presented for Committee review the continuing education courses as shown on *Attachment #3* hereto. Ms. Wallace moved to approve both education courses as indicated on *Attachment #3* hereto with Course #202200150 approved for 30 hours. Ms. Garza seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Garza announced the audit will begin shortly with the audit letters scheduled to be mailed out on August 2, 2022. Following discussion, Ms. Garza moved to appoint Mary White, OT, Jeanne Gallien Gorman, MOT, OTR/L, Jennifer Wallace, OTA, and herself to the audit subcommittee. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White and Ms. Garza presented at last year's OKOTA annual meeting and they would like to present at the meeting this year. Ms. Garza feels there is a need to let everyone know about the 30-day deadline for turning in application paperwork. Ms. Garza will ask OKOTA if they would like a separate presentation on licensing and, if so, Lisa Cullen might provide a presentation in that regard. The Committee would like information regarding CEUs to be presented and Valeska Barr will provide information to the speakers in that regard.

Ms. Garza announced that National Board of Certification for Occupational Therapy is hosting its leadership forum on September 13, 2022. Additionally, Ms. Garza announced that she was appointed as NBCOT's Ambassador for Oklahoma but has resigned from that position. NBCOT plans to appoint someone else from Oklahoma to be the Ambassador. The Ambassador would attend the OT Committee and OKOTA meetings and be a bridge between the Committee and NBCOT. This Committee asked that an update regarding this matter be placed on the October 20, 2022, meeting.

The Committee also requested that a report on the OKOTA annual meeting be added to the October 20, 2022, meeting agenda.

There being no further business, Ms. Garza moved to adjourn the meeting. The time was 10:47 a.m.
