Having noted a quorum, Barbara Smith, Executive Secretary, called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. White moved to accept the meeting minutes of July 14, 2022, as written. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ELIZABETH WILSON appeared virtually in support of her application for Occupational Therapist licensure. She is appearing under license by endorsement. She holds a current Texas license and her application is incomplete. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

LEA VALENCIA appeared virtually in support of her application for Occupational Therapist licensure. She is appearing under license by endorsement and her application is incomplete. She holds an active California license. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ASHLEY HIGHT appeared virtually in support of her application for Occupational Therapist licensure. Her application is complete. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the application pending proof of 36 CEU hours obtained within the last two years. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KASIE SCHAEFER appeared virtually in support of her application for Occupational Therapist licensure. Her application is complete. She is appearing under licensure by endorsement and holds a current California license. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the application. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

CATHERINE PAULS, OT, appeared personally in response to allegations of possibly allowing an Occupational Therapy Assistant to practice without an Oklahoma license. Ms. Pauls presented a timeline for Committee review and answered questions posed by the Committee. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend a Letter of No Tolerance placed in her file. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ALLYSON GLASS appeared personally in support of her application for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure and in response to allegations of possibly practicing without an Occupational Therapy Assistant license. Her application is complete. Ms. Glass answered questions of the Committee. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend taking no action on this application and referring it directly to the Oklahoma Medical Board for review and action. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

CHERYL BATTERMAN appeared virtually in support of her application for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure. Following review and discussion, Ms. White moved to recommend approving the application pending completion of the file to include successfully retaking the NBCOT exam. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure pending completion of the files as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Tate moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application for reinstatement of the Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure pending completion of the file as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. White seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the following complete applications for Occupational Therapy Assistant licensure as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the following incomplete applications for Occupational Therapist licensure pending completion of the files as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for reinstatement of Occupational Therapist licensure pending completion of the file as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the complete applications for Occupational Therapist licensure as listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Valeska Barr presented courses previously recommended for approval by the reviewers. Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the CEU courses indicated on *Attachment #2* hereto which were previously recommended for approval by the reviewers. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Valeska Barr presented the course previously recommended for denial by the reviewers. Ms. White moved to recommend denial of the CEU course indicated on *Attachment #3* hereto which was previously recommended for denial by the reviewers. Ms. Wallace seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Valeska Barr presented courses for the next compliance period which were previously recommended for approval by the reviewers. Ms. White moved to recommend approval of the CEU courses indicated on *Attachment #4* hereto which were previously recommended for approval by the reviewers. Ms. Tate seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. White reported on the OKOTA Annual Meeting and thanked Ms. Cullen and Ms. Barr for their licensure presentations and the booth they set up and manned during the conference. Ms. White presented on audits and ethics at the annual meeting and answered a lot of questions regarding licensure and obligations as a healthcare practitioner. She believes these presentations should be offered annually. She reported that all sessions were well attended. There was a lot of student involvement but, unfortunately, a decrease in the OT/OTA attendance.

Barbara Smith advised that future OT Committee meetings will be held on Tuesdays rather than Thursdays commencing in 2023.

The Committee welcomed the class of Oklahoma City Community College Occupational Therapy Assistant students who were attending virtually. The committee members answered questions from the students and the students thanked the committee for its time.

There being no further business, Ms. White moved to adjourn the meeting. The time was 11:25 a.m.
