

Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision
Physical Therapy Committee
Minutes
April 13, 2012

This meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51 Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act.

Noting that a quorum was present, Ms. Freudiger called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

The guests in the audience were acknowledged.

The Committee reviewed the minutes from the December, 2011 Committee meeting. Ms. Craven moved to approve the minutes. Mr. Eskew seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JENNIFER LYNN JONES, applicant for Physical Therapist License appeared in support of her application. She was arrested in April of 2009 for suspicion of DUI. It was changed to reckless driving. The charges were later expunged. She had a breathalyzer in her car for six months. She is currently working. She said there will be no future incidents. Ms. Craven moved to allow her to be licensed without any agreement. Ms. Freudiger seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

ALICIA GONZALES ARELLANO, applicant for Physical Therapist License, appeared in support of her application, specifically regarding the equivalency of her education. Her degree is from Mexico. She was to complete 50 hours by the end of December 2012. She has completed 31 of these hours. Libby Scott suggested that Ms. Arellano return before the Committee in December 2012 after all of the hours are completed. She also said no motion was needed at this time.

ABIGAIL LEE BULL applicant for Physical Therapist License, appeared in support of her application, specifically regarding her previous arrests. She was arrested for a DUI. On March 14, 2012 this arrest was expunged. Ms. Bull said she does not drink anymore. She said that she had learned her lesson and would never return. Mr. Eskew moved to recommend approval for licensure pending passing the exam. Ms. Craven seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous.

Ms. Scott's report on pending disciplinary cases. She reported that allegations had been filed against the following individuals:

***Samuel Cole Chaffin, PT** – Disciplinary hearing alleging substance abuse, violation of criminal laws/controlled substance laws, and confession of a crime. The Committee recommended at least a five year probation, and possibly as much as an indefinite probation, with the usual terms for monitoring for substance abuse. They recommended that in addition to the probation that he be suspended for a minimum of 90 days.

***Shon Wylie McBride, PTA** – Disciplinary hearing alleging substance abuse, narcotics violations and conviction/confession of a crime. Ms. Scott said staff would be proposing a five year probation with usual terms for substance abuse.

***Glen Zackery Selling, PT** – Disciplinary hearing alleging alcohol abuse, conviction of a felony, fraud in applying for renewal of license, failure to report adverse action taken by a court, and dishonorable or immoral conduct likely to deceive/defraud/harm the public. The Committee discussed their concerns about his practice in a home health setting. They directed staff to ask Mr. Selling if he would voluntarily limit his work only in the long term care facilities rather than unsupervised in homes.

Jana Lane, Investigator said she had received a complaint that she would like to discuss with the Committee. She received a call regarding non-licensed personnel performing physical therapy. The clinic in question has physical therapists, who perform the evaluation, and then aids are providing the care. The Committee discussed the job duties of a Tech/Aid. Aids may not perform the same tasks as a PTA. Aids act as an extra pair of hands while a PT or PTA provides treatment, they may ready equipment or, if properly trained, apply heat or ice, etc. The Committee also advised Ms. Lane to check billing records for fraud, as services provided by an aid may not be billed as physical therapy. Ms. Lane thanked the Committee for their assistance.

Applications for licensure and reinstatement of licensure were considered. Ms. Freudiger made a motion to recommend approval of the following applications for Physical Therapist licensure.

The PTA reinstatement application for **CAROL JEAN STATHAM** was discussed. A letter from Robyn Hall stated that Ms. Statham had contacted her saying that she had not started any of the requirements and wanted to know if there would be additional requirements imposed by the Committee at this point. It was discussed that Ms. Statham needs to let the Committee know why she had not completed the original requirements. The Committee said Ms. Statham would need an additional 30 hours plus one month of practice under director supervise for each year she was out of practice. It was recommended that she meet with the Committee.

The Committee reviewed requests for approval of continuing education courses. Ms. Freudiger made a motion to accept the hours as noted on forms. Ms. Craven seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. (See attachment #1)

Automatic approval for continuing education courses approved by the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) was discussed. Mr. Eskew made a motion that courses approved by the APTA be automatically accepted. Ms. Craven seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

The American Board of Physical Therapy Residency and Fellowship Education had submitted a request continuing education credit for clinical mentors was discussed. The Committee said up to 10

hours for PTs and five hours for PTAs could be accepted in Category B for mentoring in an accredited residency or fellowship. The Committee would work on getting the rules changed to accept the mentoring hours as Category A hours.

Continuing education audits and audit updates were discussed. Statistics were summarized by Ms. Plant. Following are the results:

Ms. Plant gave an update on proposed rulemaking OAC 435.20-5-10. She reported that the rule had been approved by the Governor and was awaiting approval by the Legislature.

It was recommended that we no longer need a recommendation as part of the application for a license. Mr. Eskew made a motion to accept this. Ms. Craven seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Plant reported on early Interventionists. Mr. Eskew agreed to be on the Committee. It was suggested that changes be gradually worked in.

Election of delegate and alternate for the FSBPT annual meeting was discussed. Ms. Plant noted that usually we send one experienced member and one new member. The Committee tabled the matter until Ms. Davis could be consulted on her preference for attending.
