Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on May 14, 2020, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held virtually in accordance with the amendments to the Open Meeting Act, 25 O.S.2011, § 301 *et seq.*, signed into law by Governor Stitt on Wednesday, March 18, 2020. (*See: SB661, 2020 O.S.L. 3, §3.*) Advance notice of this open meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 10, 2019, and posted on the Board's website on May 11, 2020, at 9:31 a.m. in accordance with Title 25 O.S. § 311.9.

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Ball called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

Following Committee review, Ms. Hinkle moved to approve the minutes of March 27, 2020, as written. Ms. Berry seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ERICA NEDLEY appeared remotely in support of her application for re-entry of Physical Therapist licensure. Ms. Nedley's license lapsed January 31 of 2019 and she last practiced in 1993. She is not licensed in another state. Ms. Nedley stated that her license lapsed due to her decision to stay at home with her children. In the interim, she has worked with exercise training and injury prevention through her husband's clinic. Her husband is a physician and together they operate Nedley Clinic. She did not receive a notice her license was expiring and she continued to obtain the required medical education courses. She resides in California 51% of the time and in Oklahoma the remaining 49%. She provides life coaching and does not practice physical therapy. Ms. Nedley advised she might be able to work in Ardmore with her son and receive required supervision in that setting. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Berry moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application of **ERICA NEDLEY** for re-entry of Physical Therapist licensure pending completion of the file to include 22 days of direct onsite supervision with a report from the supervising therapist provided to the Committee prior to licensure. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

GINA HEOGH appeared remotely in support of her application for re-entry of Physical Therapist Assistant licensure. Her license lapsed in January of 2016 and she last practiced in 2013. Ms. Heogh stated that in the interim she has been working in exercise and personal training. Her continuing education is current. Ms. Heogh further stated that she would like to bring physical therapy into her exercise facility. Her father-in law is a PT and could possibly provide required supervision. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Hinkle moved to recommend approval of the complete application of **GINA HEOGH** for re-entry of Physical Therapist Assistant licensure to include obtaining 76 continuing education hours and 88 days of direct onsite supervision with a report from the supervising therapist provided to the Committee prior to licensure. Ms. Berry seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

ELIZABETH JOUBERT appeared remotely in support of her application for Physical Therapist licensure. She is currently practicing physical therapy internationally in a very small hospital in the countryside. Her husband works in Enid and in the process of relocating to Oklahoma, she was advised by the Foreign Credentialing Commission on Physical Therapy ("FCCPT") that she had education deficiencies. Ms. Joubert advised that she has a mentor at FCCPT with whom she is working to bring her education into compliance. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Hinkle moved to table the application of **ELIZABETH JOUBERT** for Physical Therapist licensure pending completion of the coursework and a personal appearance before the Committee. Ms. Berry seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

DANIELLE OLIVER, PTA, appeared remotely in support of her request to sit a third time for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. Ms. Oliver explained life circumstances that she believes led to her failing scores. She stated she has identified her areas of weakness and presented her study plan for the committee's review. Ms. Hinkle moved to recommend approval of the request of **DANIELLE OLIVER, PTA**, to sit a third time for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. Ms. Hincke seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative with Ms. Ball abstaining.

HARLEY DODD, PTA, appeared remotely in support of his request for the special accommodation of additional time when sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. Following Committee discussion, Ms. Berry moved to recommend approval of the request of **HARLEY DODD, PTA**, for the special accommodation of additional time when sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

EMILEE BURGESS, PTA, appeared remotely in support of her request for special accommodations of additional time and zoom text (enlarged print on the computer screen) while sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. In full disclosure, Ms. Hinkle stated that Ms. Burgess is one of her students. Ms. Berry moved to recommend approval of the request of **EMILEE BURGESS, PTA**, for special accommodations of additional time and Zoom text when sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam. Ms. Marti-Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Hinkle moved to recommend approval of the complete application of **DAVID VAN TUONG** for Physical Therapist licensure. Ms. Berry seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Rachel Herbert, CEU processor, presented pre-reviewed continuing education courses for the Committee's consideration. Following Committee review, Ms. Berry moved to recommend approval of the pre-reviewed courses listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend tabling the pre-reviewed courses listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Berry moved to recommend denying the pre-reviewed courses listed on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Then, Ms. Ball led a discussion which was first brought up in the March 2020 meeting regarding the legality of physical therapists performing physicals for the Department of Transportation ("DOT"). Ms. Ball gave a brief history of the issue and reiterated that she has been contacted by a licensee who wants to know the feasibility of becoming a certified examiner for DOT. Qualifications include being licensed, certified and/or registered, and the state laws (practice act) allowing for the performance of this type of evaluation. The states that currently allow PTs to perform this examination are Texas, Arkansas, North Dakota and Louisiana. The Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration ("FMCSA") requires that the state licensure board show that it is within the scope of PT practice before this licensee can register for training. Ms. Hinkle stated she was able to determine that if the trucking is intrastate, then the state can change the requirements of whether a physical therapist may perform physicals. If it is a federal trucking company, then it is under federal jurisdiction and they have the final say. Mr. Schneider advised that the federal DOT is deferring back to Oklahoma on whether or not the state allows PTs to perform DOT physicals.

Mr. Schneider stated that he previously reviewed Title 59 O.S. Sec. 887.17.A.3 and 4 and he believes there may be some wiggle room in that statute for this type of activity.

"3. Nothing in the Physical Therapy Practice Act shall prevent a physical therapist from performing screening and educational procedures within the scope of physical therapy practice without a physician referral.

4. Nothing in the Physical Therapy Practice Act shall prevent a physical therapist from performing services that are provided for the purpose of fitness, wellness, or prevention that is not related to the treatment of an injury or ailment."

He went on to state that the Physical Therapy Practice Act does not prevent nor expressly state this is allowed. He advised the question to be considered is: Is what the person is performing the practice of physical therapy or is it not?

Ms. Ball stated the course for certification is live and a test is given at the end to ensure competency. Further, Ms. Ball has performed examinations similar to these and believes it is fairly straightforward.

After much discussion, Ms. Martin-Davis moved to recommend that the performance of Department of Transportation physical evaluations is allowed under the Oklahoma Physical Therapy Practice Act under Title 59 O.S. Sec. 887.17.A.3 and 4, or in the alternative it is not expressly prohibited. Ms. Hinkle seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, Ms. Ball presented a Power Point from the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy "Alternative Approval Pathway." Ms. Ball asked for clarification regarding the Committee's authority to approve the Alternate Approval Pathway. Mr. Schneider referenced Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-3-5.D which states, "No person shall be admitted for examination until satisfactory evidence is presented by the Board of qualifications." He went on to say a rule change is required before the Committee or Medical Board may approve the Alternative Approval Pathway, and perhaps a law change as well. He also referenced Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-3-1, which sets out the qualifications for licensure.

The process now includes a determination that the applicant is a graduate, a review to confirm that all required coursework has been completed, completion of a background check and evidence of status received. Once the required paperwork is completed, the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy ("FSBPT") is notified that the applicant is eligible to sit for the licensure examination. If Oklahoma adopted the Alternative Approval Pathway, the applicant would submit an application which will be pending, and then the applicant would separately apply to FSBPT to sit for examination. Once the examination scores were complete and submitted to the Medical Board, a determination regarding licensure eligibility would then be made. The Committee took no formal action on this matter at this time.

Ms. Berry opened a discussion regarding potentially modifying the Physical Therapy Practice Act and/or administrative rules to include permanent provisions of telehealth services. It was determined that a subcommittee should be appointed of members who cover a mix of practice areas to help with the process of drafting proposed language. Mr. Schneider advised that a law change would be required. Once the law is approved, emergency rules setting out specifics regarding teletherapy services could be drafted. He believes that in light of the COVID-19 Pandemic, we have sufficient evidence to support this amendment.

Reji Varghese, Deputy Director, has recently worked with the occupational therapists ("OTs") to get telework approved. He gave a brief overview of the process. He stated that initially the subcommittee should look at the other states who have existing teletherapy laws and rules in place, and then begin drafting new definitions for the practice act. It is also important to have the support of the state association. Tele-Alliance of Oklahoma, as well as the speech and audiology associations, might be of some assistance.

Ms. Berry provided a handout regarding the use of tele-therapy in the practice of physical therapy in other states. Mr. Varghese stated that the first meeting of the subcommittee could be to review the document and divide up tasks. Also, the subcommittee will need to find two favorable legislators, one in the House and one in the Senate, to author the bill by mid-December of this year for the next legislative session.

Ms. Berry stated she will work on putting together a subcommittee and working on possible definitions for the Practice Act prior to the December filing deadline. Ms. Martin-Davis volunteered to serve on the subcommittee.

A staff directive was issued to place a review and update on the next meeting agenda as

well as appointment of subcommittee members.

Upon questioning, Mr. Varghese advised that the CEU review portal will be active within the next two weeks.

Ms. Ball thanked Carla Hinkle and Mitsy Martin-Davis for their work on the Committee as their terms are expiring.

There being no further business, Ms. Hinkle moved to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Martin-Davis seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative. The time was 11:29 a.m.
