#### Physical Therapy Advisory Committee

#### Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on December 5, 2023, at 9:00 AM at the office of the Board at 101 NE 51<sup>st</sup> Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. This regular meeting is being held consistent with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 22, 2022, and posted on the Board's website on December 4, 2023, at 8:10 AM in accordance with Title 25 O.S. § 311(A)(9).

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Berry called the meeting to order at 9:00 AM. Barbara Smith confirmed the quorum via roll call for purposes of the record.

Following Committee review, Ms. Lawrence moved to approve the minutes of October 17, 2023, as written. Ms. Mason seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**NOELLE CARBONE** appeared virtually in support of her application for Physical Therapist licensure. Her application is incomplete. Although she qualifies for licensure by endorsement, her practice history portion of the application is blank. The applicant stated she tried to update her work history, but the system would not allow her to do so. She went on to state she worked as a PT at Vestal Physical Therapy in Vestal, NY from April 2021 to September 2023. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend licensure by endorsement. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**EUGENIA DEAN** appeared virtually in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure. Her Oklahoma license lapsed in January of 2023 and she last practiced in 2021. Her application is incomplete. She obtained some continuing education courses in 2022. The applicant was advised that all of her Professional Development Unit (PDU) courses will be

due for this renewal period by January 31<sup>st</sup>, if she completes the recommendations of the committee. Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file to include proof of obtaining 30 PDUs and completing 18 days of direct supervision with an adequate report provided by the supervising Physical Therapist at the conclusion thereof. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KIMBERLY FARLEY appeared in person in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure. Her license lapsed in January of 2023 and she last practiced at that time. The applicant stated she had an Oklahoma Tax Commission hold placed on her license and was unable to renew her license timely. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file to include proof of obtaining 30 PDUs and completing 18 days of direct supervision with an adequate report provided by the supervising Physical Therapist at the conclusion thereof. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**JUDITH HANSON** appeared personally in support of her application for Physical Therapist licensure. Her application is incomplete. She has a current license in Maryland but has not practiced hands-on therapy since January of 2018. Following discussion, Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend licensure by endorsement pending completion of the file. Ms. Mason seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KRISTIE MEEK appeared personally in support of her application for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure. She last practiced in May of 2014 and her license lapsed January of 2020. Her application is incomplete. She did not obtain any PDUs for the 2020 compliance period. Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the application pending completion of the file to include proof of obtaining 120 PDUs and completing 84 days of direct supervision with an adequate report provided by the supervising Physical Therapist at the conclusion thereof. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**CATHERINE BOWLING,** Physical Therapist, appeared virtually in support of her request to supervise additional PTAs. She is currently a supervisor in the public school system and wishes to move from a group setting to PTAs being individually supervised directly under her. Following discussion with the committee members and staff, Ms. Bowling withdrew her request and stated she wishes to continue with group supervision.

GARRETT PEARSON, applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared virtually in support of his request for special accommodations while testing. Mr. Pearson is requesting time and a half while testing. Following review, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the request for special accommodations of time and a half while testing. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**KENZIE FEW,** applicant, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend granting the request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**COURTNEY GARD,** applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend granting the request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**KAMRYN HAYNE,** applicant, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

MIKENZI RICHARDS, applicant, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Richards stated she has registered to sit for the exam in Kansas. It was determined that the Committee has no jurisdiction to make a recommendation for Kansas testing and Ms. Richards withdrew her request.

**ASHLIE ROSE,** applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared personally in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**RUBY VENZOR-CADENA,** applicant, Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Venzor-Cadena stated she has registered to sit for the exam in Kansas. It was stated that the Committee has no jurisdiction to make a recommendation for Kansas testing and Ms. Venzor-Cadena withdrew her request.

**BRAYLON WARRIOR,** applicant, Physical Therapist, appeared virtually in support of his request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**DENA OHL,** Physical Therapist Assistant, appeared virtually in support of her request for a lesser professional development requirement. She is not currently working but would like to keep her license active. Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the request for a reduction in required PDUs to 15 hours for the current cycle only. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Following Committee review, Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure pending completion of the files as shown on Attachment #1 hereto. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for Physical Therapist licensure pending completion of the files as shown on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the continuing education courses previously reviewed and recommended for approval by the education subcommittee as shown on *Attachment* #2 hereto. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Mason moved to recommend denial of the continuing education courses previously reviewed and recommended for denial by the education subcommittee as shown on *Attachment #3* hereto. Ms. Lawrence seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Ms. Mason moved to recommend approval of the continuing education providers previously reviewed and recommended for approval by the education subcommittee and as shown on *Attachment #4* hereto.

Next, the Committee discussed the reapproval process for Professional Development Providers through CE Broker. Ms. Harrison referred to Okla. Admin. Code 435:20-9-3.1.1(b) which states "Once a provider is approved, the professional development activities offered by that organization are approved for credit and no application must be made to the Board for approval." Since there is no "reapproval" process set forth in the law/rules, all previously approved providers are authorized to renew each compliance period through CE Broker.

Under "New Business," Ms. Smith discussed with the Committee protocol related to applicant's questions regarding potential recommendations of the Committee prior to a motion and vote. Sometimes, allowing an in-depth discussion with an applicant about what the Committee is thinking or what it is "leaning towards" as far as recommendations, can lead to confusion for the applicant if the actual motion differs from part of the discussion. The Committee thanked Ms. Smith for the information.

There being no further business, Ms. Berry moved to adjourn the meeting. The time was 11:21 a.m.
