

Physical Therapy Advisory Committee
Minutes

The Physical Therapy Committee of the Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on January 28, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. at the office of the Board at 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. This meeting was held consistent with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 15, 2024, and posted on the Board's website on January 16, 2025, at 10:13 a.m. in accordance with Title 25 O. S. § 311(A)(9).

Having noted a quorum, Ms. Mason called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. For purposes of the record, Barbara Smith confirmed the quorum via roll call.

Oklahoma Medical Board Director's Comments: Ms. Harrison advised that legislative session begins next week and there is one bill currently which relates to physical therapy. Ms. Harrison will provide a copy electronically to the Committee for informational purposes and feedback. She further advised that as a state agency, we do not take positions on bills but we do provide technical assistance to bill authors upon request.

Following Committee review, Mr. Kendall moved to approve the minutes of the December 3, 2024, meeting as written. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

KENZIE FEW, applicant, Physical Therapist Assistant licensure, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy examination for a third time. Ms. Few previously provided her study guide for Committee review. Following review and discussion, and advising this is the last time she will be eligible to sit for the exam in Oklahoma, Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approving Ms. Few to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

PHILEMON NARTEY, applicant, Physical Therapist licensure, appeared virtually in support of his request for special accommodations while sitting for the Federation of State Boards

of Physical Therapy examination. He previously appeared before the Committee on August 6, 2024, and was approved for the special accommodations of double time and a separate room. However, when he took the test, he wanted two days to test which had not been previously approved. Following review and discussion, Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend special accommodations of double time, a separate room, and splitting the test over two days while sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy examination pending clarification by Lisa Cullen that test sections are closed and unable to be re-accessed once completed. Mr. Kendall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

MADLINE ROSE, applicant, Physical Therapist licensure, appeared virtually in support of her request to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy examination for a third time. Ms. Rose previously provided her study guide for Committee review. Following review and discussion, Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approving Ms. Rose to sit for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy exam a third time. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

YULISSA VASQUEZ, applicant, Physical Therapist licensure, appeared virtually in support of her request for special accommodations while sitting for the Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy examination. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approving special accommodations of extended time, which is time and a half, and a separate room. Mr. Kendall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee reviewed applications and made recommendations as indicated below:

1. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application(s) for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure as shown on *Attachment #1* pending completion of the file(s). Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
2. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approval of the complete application(s) for Physical Therapist Assistant licensure as shown on *Attachment #1*. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
3. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application(s) for Physical Therapist licensure as shown on *Attachment #1* pending completion of the file(s). Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
4. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approval of the incomplete application(s) for reinstatement of Physical Therapist licensure as shown on *Attachment #1* pending completion of the file(s). Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.
5. Ms. Lawrence moved to recommend approval of the complete application(s) for Physical Therapist licensure as shown on *Attachment #1*. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Kendall moved to recommend ratifying the continuing education courses and providers previously reviewed and recommended for approval by the CEU/PDU Review Subcommittee from October 1, 2024 to December 31, 2024 pursuant to applicable rule. Ms. Chamberlain seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Following discussion, Ms. Mason moved to reappoint Kelly Berry and Debbie Hicks to the Educational (CEU/PDU) Review Subcommittee. Mr. Kendall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee considered elections for the **Voting Delegate, Alternate Delegate, and Funded Administrator** to represent Oklahoma at the **Federation of State Boards of Physical Therapy**. Ms. Mason moved to self-nominate as Voting Delegate, to nominate Mr. Stanley as Alternate, and defer the Funded Administrator position up to board staff. Mr. Kendall seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Review and discussion regarding possible administrative rule amendments to **Okla. Admin. Code 435:20**. Ms. Harrison reported that last week she presented at the House Administrative Rules Committee. There is an Executive Order requiring us to remove two current rules for each new rule we propose be implemented. Currently, there is a piece of legislation pending that will make that law. One of the questions she was asked was if we are looking at modernizing rules in step with all statutes. The Medical Board members want processes to be streamlined. She further advised that in review of the PT CEUs and PDUs, there was a 17 percent failure rate of our audited licensees so she is looking at those specific rules to be possibly reworked. Staff will draft proposed amendments and Ms. Harrison will provide a copy electronically to the Committee before the next meeting. In closing, Ms. Harrison requested Valeska Barr to attend the next meeting on April 22nd to discuss CEUs/PDUs.

There being no further business, Ms. Mason adjourned the meeting. The time was 9:43 a.m.
