

Minutes

The Physician Assistant Advisory Committee of the Oklahoma Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision met on October 20, 2022, in accordance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Advance notice of this regularly scheduled meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on October 15, 2021. The notice and agenda were posted on the Board's website on October 7, 2022, at 1:36 p.m. pursuant to 25 O.S. § 311(A)(9).

Having noted a quorum, Mr. Burke called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Mr. Burke thanked the committee members for being in attendance.

Following Committee review, Mr. Flinn moved to approve the meeting minutes of July 14, 2022 as written. Dr. Womack seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

JULIE MERITT appeared personally in support of her application for Physician Assistant licensure. She last practiced in June of 2013 and her NCCPA expired December 31, 2015. The applicant stated she plans to sit for her recertification exam in a couple of months and she has obtained approximately 25 hours of CMEs. She does not have any current employment opportunities. She has been a stay-at-home mother for the last nine (9) years. The Committee expressed concern with her being out of practice for nine (9) years. Following discussion, Mr. Flinn moved to table the application pending the applicant successfully completing the NCCPA certification examination and obtaining 25 hours of CME with a personal appearance before the Committee at the completion thereof. Ms. Douglas seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

**Mr. Bosse joined the meeting.*

LAURA MILLER personally appeared in support of her application for Physician Assistant licensure. She last practiced in 2005 and her NCCPA certification expired December 31, 2003. She is not currently licensed in another state. She plans to take the PANCE in either December of 2022 or January of 2023. She has obtained fifty (50) CMEs and plans to obtain an additional fifty (50) in the coming months. She has an opportunity to work in Social Security Disability providing examinations and possibly attend a “PA Residency” that is offered in Moore, Oklahoma. She would be shadowing PAs at the Social Security Disability clinic. Mr. Flinn moved to table the application pending successfully completing the NCCPA certification examination with a personal appearance before the Committee at the completion thereof. Mr. Bosse seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, the Committee reviewed applications for licensure. Mr. Flinn moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for Physician Assistant licensure pending completion of the files as indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto. Dr. Womack seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Flinn moved to recommend approval of complete applications for reinstatement of Physician Assistant licensure as indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto. Ms. Douglas seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Dr. Womack moved to recommend approval of the incomplete applications for reinstatement of Physician Assistant licensure pending completion of the file as indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto. Mr. Flinn seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Bosse moved to recommend approval of the complete applications for Physician Assistant licensure as indicated on *Attachment #1* hereto. Mr. Flinn seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Mr. Kelsey presented an interim report on proposed **Physician Assistant Administrative Rules, Okla. Admin. Code 435:15**. Dr. Katsis, Chair, Dr. Cox, Dr. Ross Vanhooser, Mr. Bob Howard, and Lyle Kelsey make up the Board’s subcommittee on the proposed rules. All subcommittee members, Barbara Smith, and Patti Parrish, JD, were present at the recent subcommittee meeting. The subcommittee spent time going through the public comments and identified issues surrounding prescribing of Schedule IIs and the supervision ratio between PAs and MDs. Mr. Kelsey stated the subcommittee is spending a lot of time working to ensure the rules will relate to the “real life” practice of medicine while also protecting the public/patient care. The subcommittee would like additional information on PAs practicing in other states. The subcommittee will continue to meet and work to prepare a draft of rules for submission to the full Board. Mr. Flinn stated there is an issue with not being able to prescribe Schedule IIs as the current rules are written.

Barbara Smith advised that future Physician Assistant Advisory Committee meetings will be moving from Thursdays to Tuesdays commencing in 2023.

There being no further business, Mr. Burke moved to adjourn the meeting. The time was 3:58 P.M.
